

Technology Integration Lesson Plan

Lesson: Semester Review in a Power Point Presentation

Length: 3 days

Grade: 8th U.S. History

Brief Description of Lesson: (Strategies) Students will use a PowerPoint template to create a presentation that is actually a semester review. Mr. McConnell's class will do their presentation on the Bill of Rights.

Technology TEKS: (Objectives)

Students are expected to do the following:

1. Adjust the master slide.
2. Insert graphics, motion clips, sounds and movie clips.
3. Work between 2 applications—Power Point, and Internet.
4. Use action buttons.
5. Use online help for Power Point.

History Objectives:

1. Identify colonial grievances listed in the Declaration of Independence and explain how those grievances were addressed in the U.S. Constitution and the Bill of Rights
2. Analyze how the U.S. Constitution reflects the principles of limited government, republicanism, checks and balances, federalism, separation of powers, popular sovereignty, and individual rights
3. Summarize rights guaranteed in the Bill of Rights
4. Identify the influence of ideas from the Declaration of Independence on the US system of government

Day One Strategies and procedures:

1. Review students on Power Point
 - a. Insert pictures from files
 - b. Adding text, copy and paste graphic from internet
2. Students open PowerPoint template with directions.
3. Students begin completing the text for each slide and inserting graphics where appropriate.

Day Two Strategies and procedures:

1. Teach the following:
 - a. Inserting sounds
 - b. Getting movie clips and inserting them.
2. Students continue working on slide show and doing research.

Day Three Strategies and procedures:

1. Students will continue adding slides and researching their person or event.
2. Teach how to hyperlink slides to each other and add action buttons.
3. Students print out slide show as handouts.

Assessment: Teacher will assess the completed presentation for a technology grade and a content grade.

Materials Needed: PowerPoint template, graphic and music files.
