

EASTER AT HOME PROGRAM **BUSY BUGS BUNNY**

What's up doc? It's me Bugs Bunny, and it is Easter season.
If you don't know me, well here is a short introduction:

Bugs wakes up early every morning, and since he eats a lot of carrots, he must brush his teeth every day. So, that his teeth are clean, healthy and strong to eat more delicious carrots.

Inspection: Big Smiles

(5 minutes)



Hop along to the bathroom and go brush your teeth.

Make sure you brush your teeth properly and floss.

You know what bunnies are good at? They are very good at hopping all over the place, and you cubs are going to do the same. Let's play a game of hopscotch.



Game: Hopscotch

(5 minutes)

Equipment needed:

- Tape
- Scissors
- Cleared hard floor

Adults- Send up an indoor (or outdoor) hopscotch, using tape. You decide what number to go up to, depending on space. Let the whole family participate, see who can do it the fastest.



Did you know Bugs bunny is smart, but he is also an artist? Bugs is very impressed with your big smiles and will share some creative art tips with you. There are 2 creative art tips you can do one or both.

Craft Activity: Bubbles and Foam Art

(25 minutes)

1. Bubble Painting

Materials needed:

- cups
- straws
- paint (acrylic paint but you can try others)
- dish detergent
- water
- cardstock- thick paper

Add about 1 tablespoon of paint color, 2 tablespoons dish detergent, and 2 tablespoons of water to each cup.

Mix each cup using the straw and start blowing bubbles. Once the bubbles rise above the rim of the cup, lay your paper over the bubbles. Then remove the paper and repeat with a different color paint. It's as simple as that!

Allow it to dry. Once dry you can cut out shapes, like a heart or a star.



2. Foam/Puffy painting

Materials needed:

- 1 cup of flour
- 3 teaspoons of baking soda
- 1 teaspoon of salt
- about 1-1/4 cup of water
- food colouring
- plastic squeeze bottle or zip lock bag (cut off a corner)

Start by mixing the flour, baking soda, and salt together. Then gradually add in the water. Pour enough water in until it starts to look like pancake batter. Then mix in your colour. You could divide this mixture and then add food coloring so you can make multiple colors out of one batch.



Whilst we let your artwork dry out. Let's play a game with your family.

The game is an egg and spoon race. Bugs says it not about the speed that wins a race but how concentrated you are.

Game: Egg and spoon race

(10 minutes)

Equipment needed: (minimum 2 people, you can have more people take part or switch with a family member)

- Eggs – preferably hard-boiled eggs (not Easter eggs)
- spoons

Demarcate the start and finish line. The egg is placed on the spoon. Do different races, one with holding the spoon with one hand and the next holding the spoon with your teeth or running backwards or side wards.

Take a video and sent to Akela.



Bugs loves giving gifts to his friends and family. You can use his art tips to make gift cards for your handmade gifts. A handmade gift lets someone feel extra special because rather than giving a store-bought present, you chose to put your time creating something. Without a doubt, the person who will receive it will feel nothing but good vibes. Since it is Easter season, Bugs says he needs your help in making some gifts for your family and gift for essential workers.

Activity: Making a handmade gift

(40 minutes)

Silver Wolf: Make a gift and give it to a friend or family member. (Either make the paper bunny craft or pom pom bunny*). Follow the step by step video.
*this one requires wool.

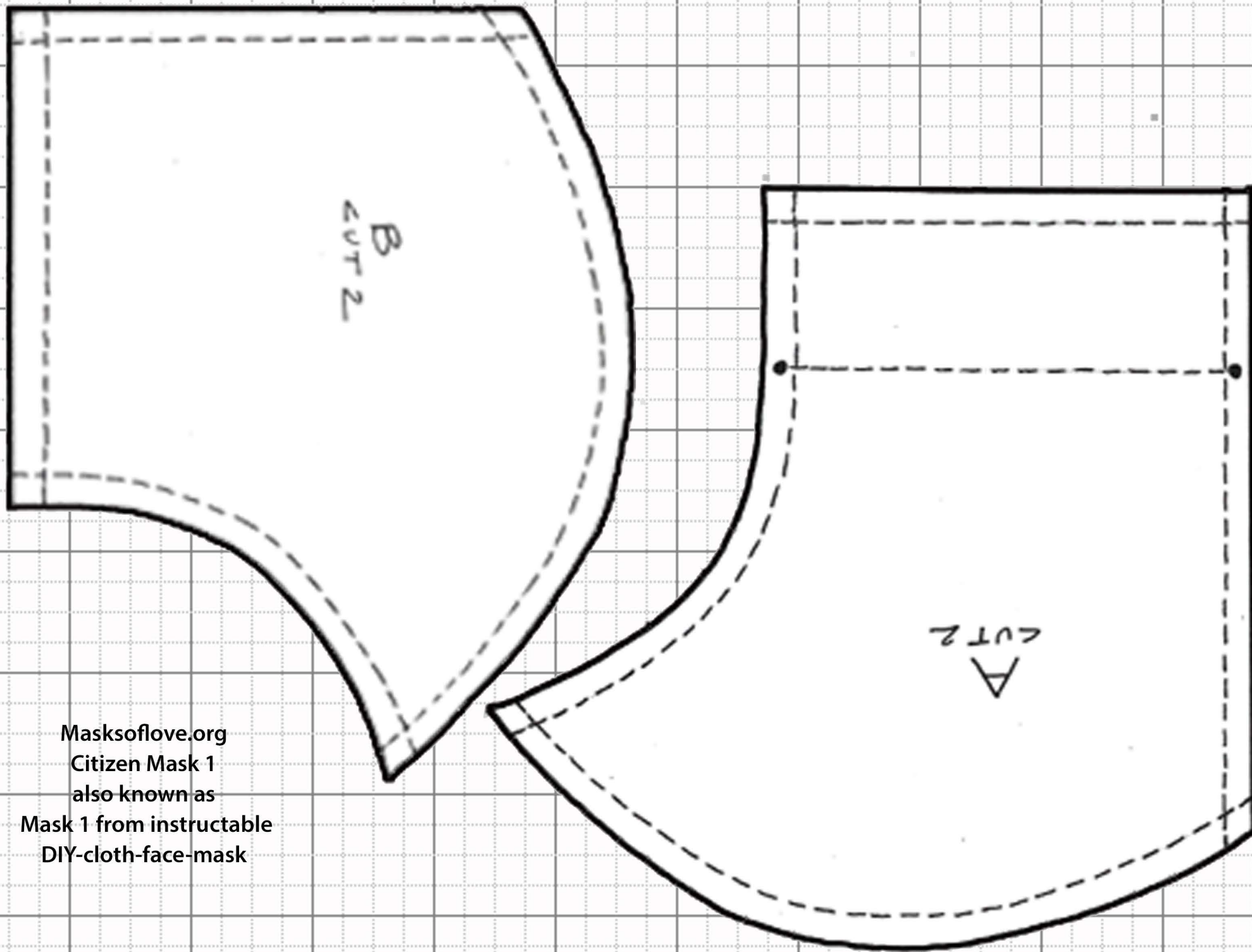
Materials needed:

(10 minutes)

Adults – Print out both DTD activities on the last three pages.

If you don't have a printer, you could screenshot the image on a tablet or pc and use paint or any image app to draw on top of the picture.

Give your cub 5 minutes for each, later he/she can colour them in.

Cubs, when you have discovered who Bug's secret friend is send a picture to Akela and tell Akela the super-secret! Akela knows the secret so it's okay to tell her.

So, now you know Bugs Bunny is friends with the Easter Bunny! The Easter bunny has given the adult/s something below, which they have to prepare. You must find what he has left for you.



Game: Scavenger hunt

(15-20 minutes)

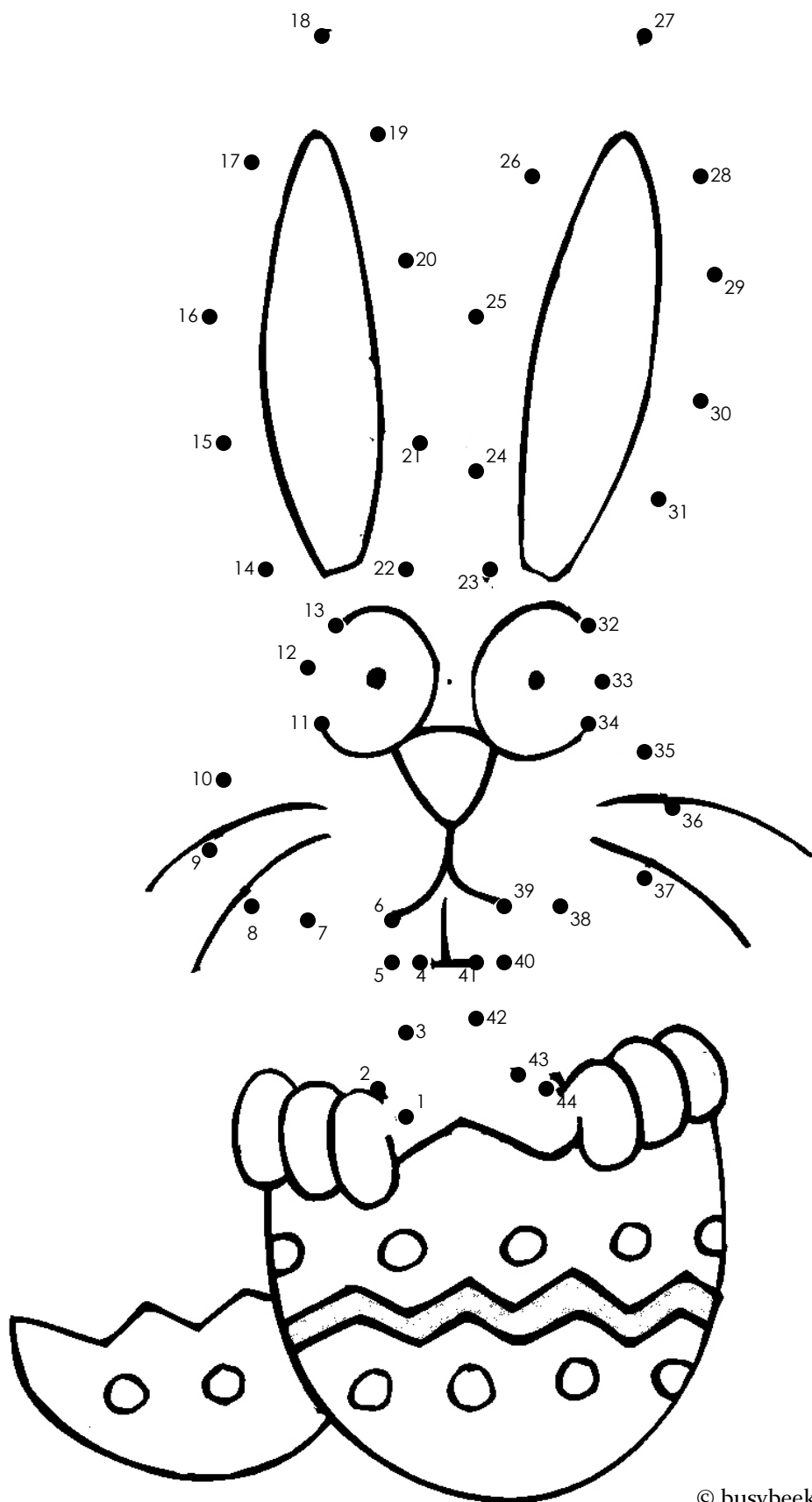
