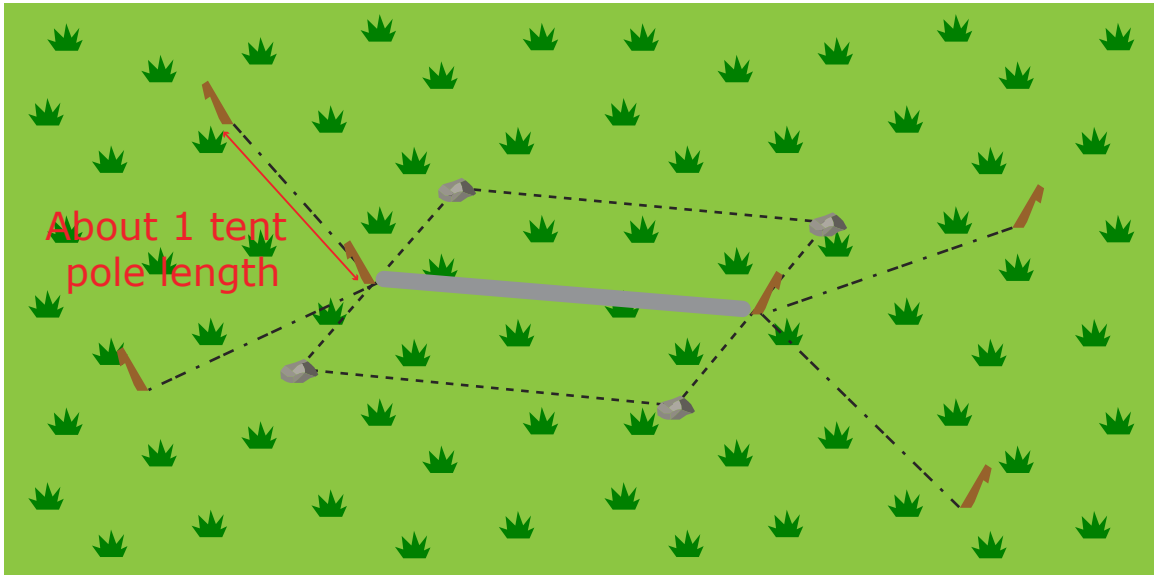


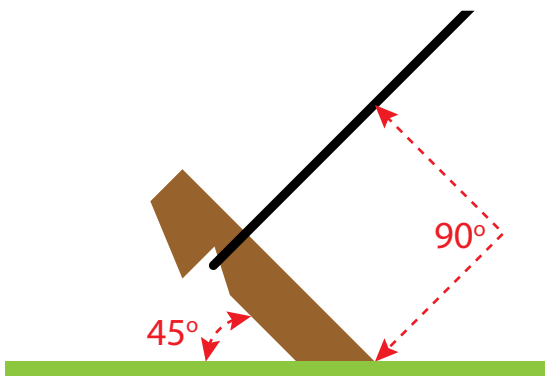
TENT PITCHING

Roughly mark the position of the tent using stones or pegs as markers.



1. Place the ridge pole along the ground as shown. Place tent peg markers at each end. Next position four pegs to take the main guys as shown here.
2. Get the tent ready for pitching by putting the uprights and ridge pole into position and place the tent on the ground with the uprights at the marker pegs.
3. Attach the main guys to the top of the pole. Loop those on the one side of the tent to the pegs already placed. Now go to the other side of the tent and use the guys to pull the tent upright. Attach these guys to the remaining two pegs.
4. Finally, put in all the other pegs, adjust the runners and if necessary move the main guys and pegs to get a tidy effect. All guy ropes must line up with the tent seams. If it is not wet roll up the sides and flaps

TENT PEGS: in line at 45 to ground for maximum strength.



GUY LINES: should run in line with seams on canvas, avoids creases.

EAVES: should always extend over the walls, then rain water will run off canvas
