

UNIFORM:

CORRECT POSITION OF BADGES.

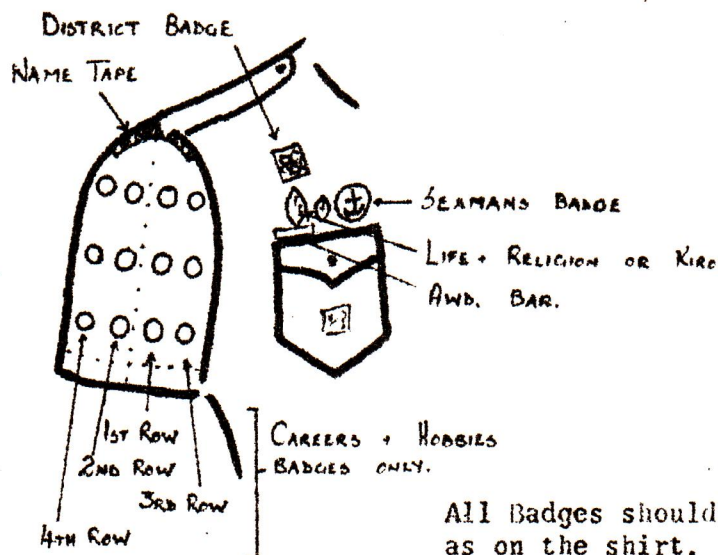
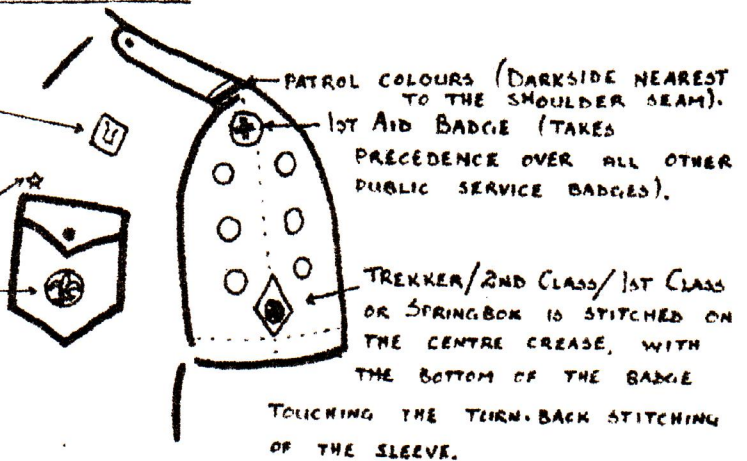
There is a set position for every badge that goes onto your uniform. Nothing looks more unsightly than to see several Scouts who have the same badge, wearing it in a different position. Another important factor, is the manner in which the badge has been attached to the uniform. Press-studs, pins and large stitches are not only very untidy but press-studs tend to rust, pins make holes in an expensive uniform and in the case of large stitches, the badge starts to fray at the edges and tends to curl.

Lets start with the Sea Scout Summer Shirts: Blue Shirt & White Dress Shirt.

LEFT FRONT AND SLEEVE.

THE LEAPING WOLF BADGE IS SITUATED MIDWAY BETWEEN THE TOP OF THE POCKET AND EPAULETTE + CENTRE FRONT AND ARMHOLE SEAM. SERVICE STAR JUST ABOVE + IN LINE WITH RIGHT HAND SIDE OF THE POCKET.

SEA SCOUT JERSEY.

All Badges should be in the identical position as on the shirt. If you have any problems as to where the pocket should be, lay the jersey out flat and place the shirt on top, level at the shoulders. For correct shoulder position, put the jersey on.

SCARF: The apex of your scarf should finish 5 finger depth from the neck fold.
