

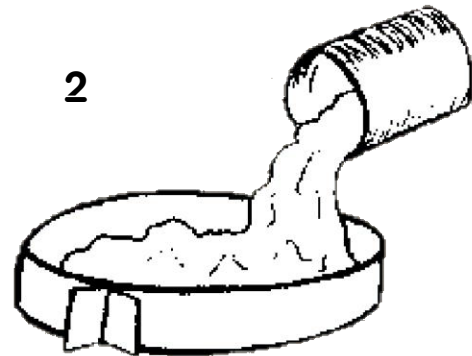
PLASTER CASTS



Make a cardboard collar and place around track



Detail of the joint of the collar



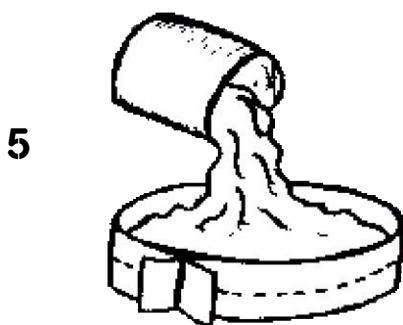
Pour in the prepared plaster of paris.
Pour in carefully so as not to
spoil the track



Remove mould cast and brush off dirt.
Make sure the track is clean. Rub a little
vaseline to stop sticking.



Place collar around
the track mould



Pour in plaster of paris. Leave
for about an hour.



Remove cast and clean rub with
sand paper to remove roughness

NOTE:

When mixing plaster stir well. Make the plaster to the same consistency as thick cream. Take care to break up lumps. Be sure to label all casts with place found, date and type of track.
