

CONSTELLATION VIEWER

Supplies

- paper towel roll
- black paper cut in 4-inch squares
- a Sharpie
- a toothpick
- Constellation guide, sky map, or space app for your device

Instructions:

- Snip out your constellation patterns around the outer dots.
- Glue your cut-outs to the center of your black paper.
- Place your paper onto the corkboard, right side up, and pierce each constellation hole (star) with your pin/needle.
- Cut around your constellation pattern, leaving at least 3cm of black paper surrounding it.
- Then make cuts from the outer edge of the construction paper into the center, but do not cut into the constellation pattern.
- Place the constellation pattern over your toilet roll tube, right side up, and fold over your pieces of black paper, securing them in place with tape, or a rubber band.
- Mark each tube with the name of the constellation according to its dotted pattern.
