

## ACTIVATE EMERGENCY SERVICES



**Emergency number for the police**

**10111**

To report a serious crime – ongoing or otherwise – this is the number you need to dial. Stay on the line and give as much detail as you can, and don't hang up until a unit has been dispatched to your area.



**Number for an ambulance or the fire department**

**10177**

This is a non-crime related number and best to use if there has been an accident rather than injuries resulting from criminal activity. **If you need to report a fire, this is your go-to number as well.**



**Number for any emergency**

**112**

Whether it's a medical issue, one of fire or even crime, calling 112 will allow an operator to patch you through to the relevant department..

When you call for help, be ready to provide the following information:

- your name
- your location/address
- description of the emergency
- number of persons ill or injured
- your phone number
