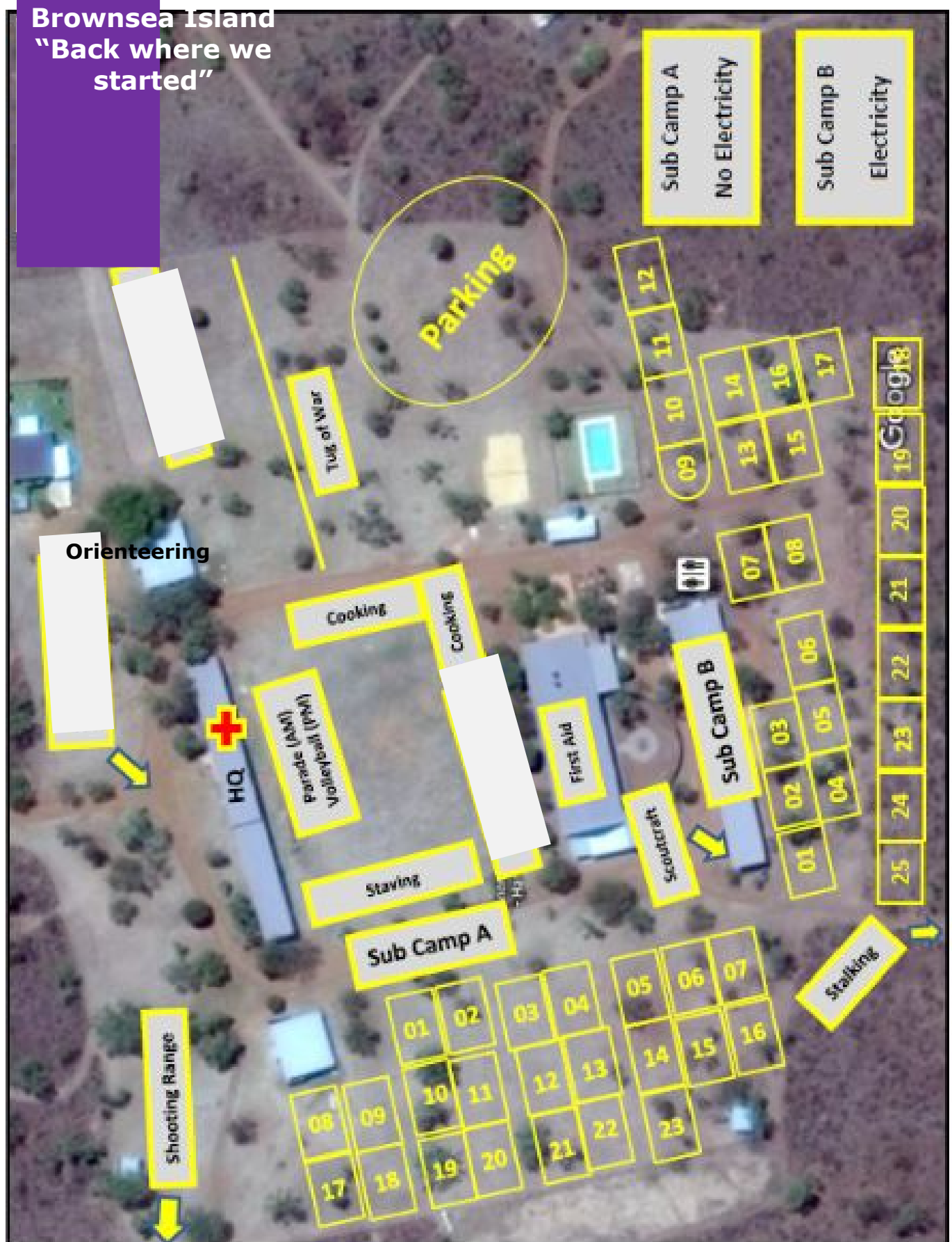

Notes:

- Winners of Field Day 2019 (**10th Arcadia**) break flag at Opening Ceremony and to supply Troop Flag for HQ flagpole.
- Scout Law is the law of Field Day.
- Showers: consider others – do not use all the hot water.
- Ablutions are specifically designated: please note these are split between adults and youth – **upper ablution block is for adults ONLY**.
- Adhere to the Voortrekker regulations at all times.
- Clean up ablutions / toilet areas after use.
- All waste bagged (no wet / dry pits) – disposed as required by site.
- Do not cross campsite boundaries – use gates to enter sites.
- **Fires:** remember that grass is dry this time of year.
- General speed limit in Hartebeestfontein – 15kph.
- All lost / found property to be handed in at Operations Centre.
- Troops not represented at TS briefing will receive penalty points against overall standing.
- No Scouts allowed in Operations Centre, kitchen, staff sleeping quarters, adult ablutions (behind kitchen).
