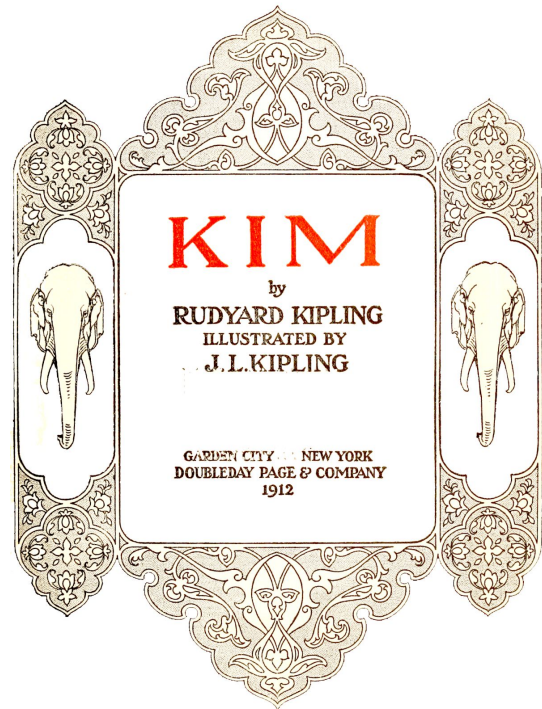


Draw a map of a house and garden

Kim was an Irish boy who lived in India more than 100 years ago. Rudyard Kipling, who wrote the Jungle Book, also wrote a book about Kim.

Kim often went exploring. To find his way, he always started by remembering which way the sun rose and set. At night, he could tell from the stars which way was North. He knew which way the trees bent in the wind, which direction the rain clouds came from, and which way the birds flew on their way to roost in the evening.

But Kim had another secret - he was a spy! And sometimes he was sent to draw a map of the enemy's territory. No-one would suspect an innocent-looking boy of doing such important secret work!



Please take a sheet of paper and a pencil to draw a map of the cottage and garden that Kim is visiting secretly today.

Kim stood at the gateway, looking into the garden.

- The entrance to the garden was between two square gate posts
- In front of him, there was a straight path paved with bricks
- On either side of the path was a row of small plants
- To the left of the path was an orange tree
- There were 5 oranges growing in the tree
- On the right of the path was a round pond
- There were 3 heart-shaped water lily leaves in the pond, and one water lily flower
- At the end of the path there were three steps leading into a square cottage

Kim went up the steps and quietly opened the door.

- The cottage was a single square room.
- To the right of the door was a small round table
- There were 3 chairs at the table.
- To the left was a rectangular rug with tassles on each end
- Straight ahead of him was the back door of the cottage
- To the right of the back door was a basin for washing
- There were two taps on the basin
- To the left of the back door there was a bed with a pillow on it
