

A natural source of folate.

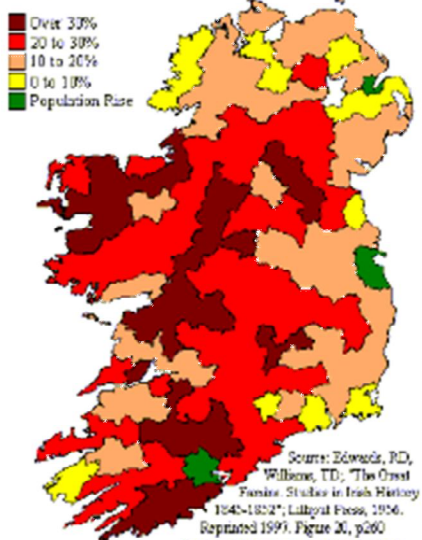




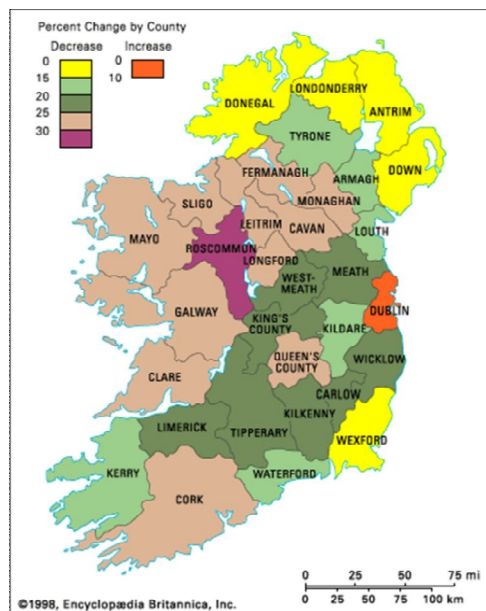


THE EJECTMENT.
