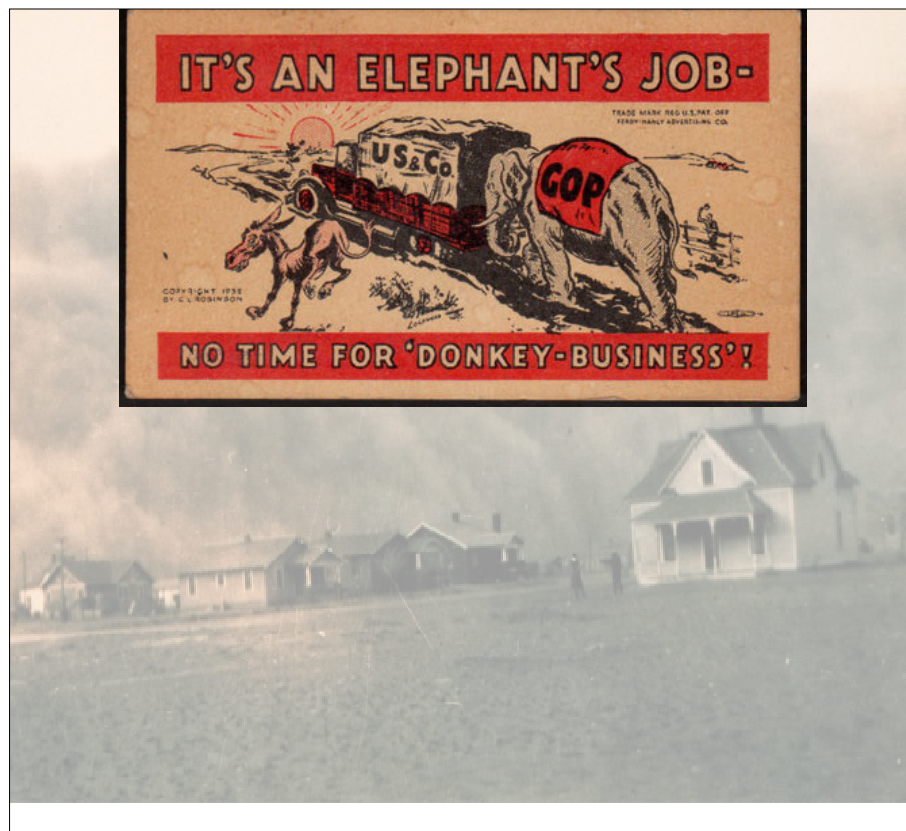

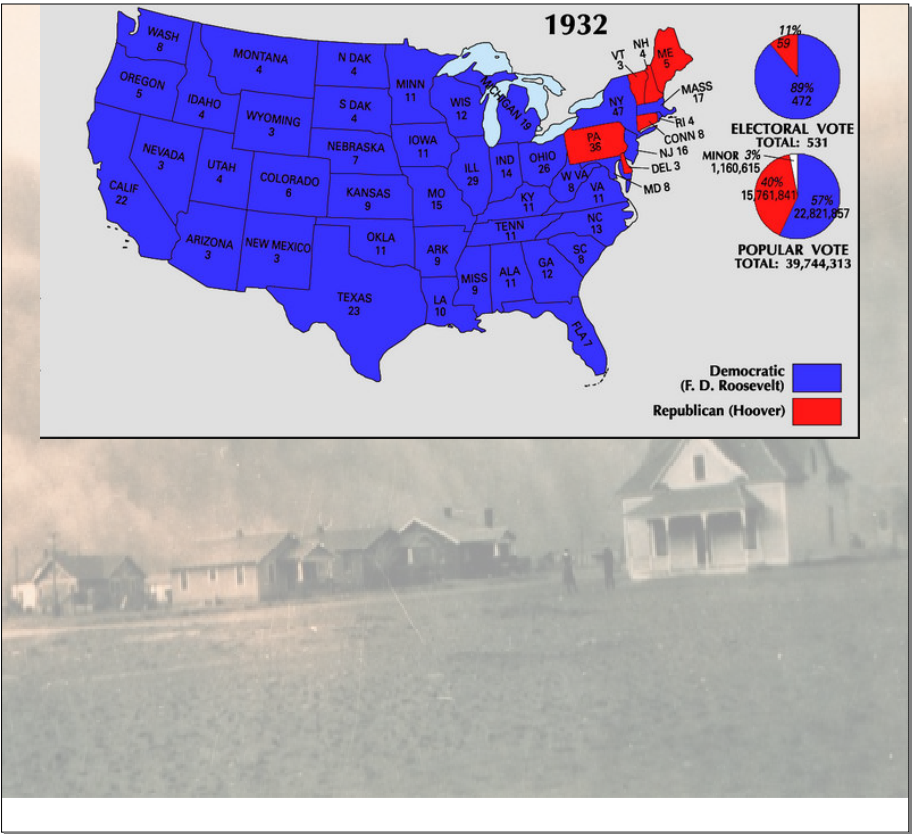

FDR

- 1910- New York State Senate
 - Reelected for second term in 1912
 - Resigns March 17, 1913
- Appointed Assistant Secretary of the Navy
 - By Woodrow Wilson (1913)
 - Developed longtime affection for the navy
- Ran for Vice President in 1920
 - Lost and retired to a New York law practice

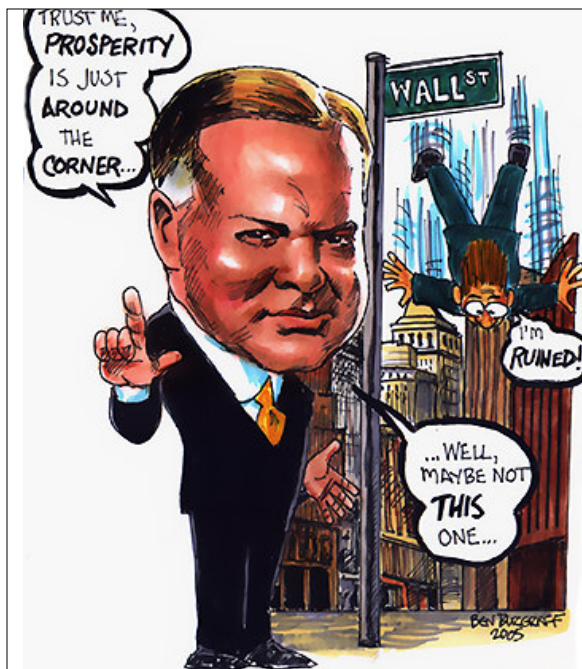
