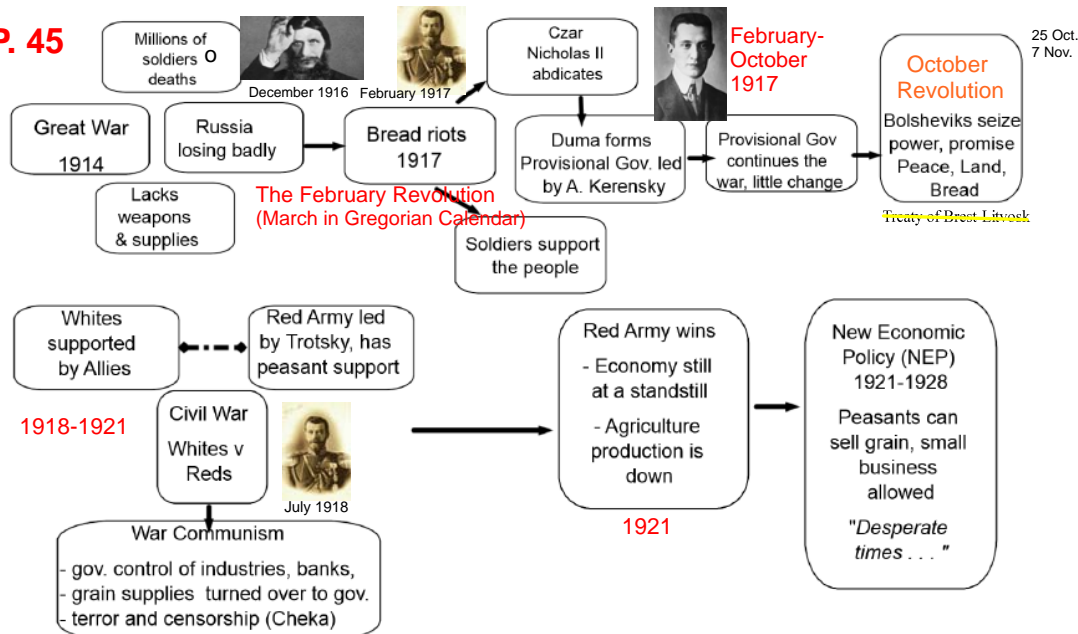

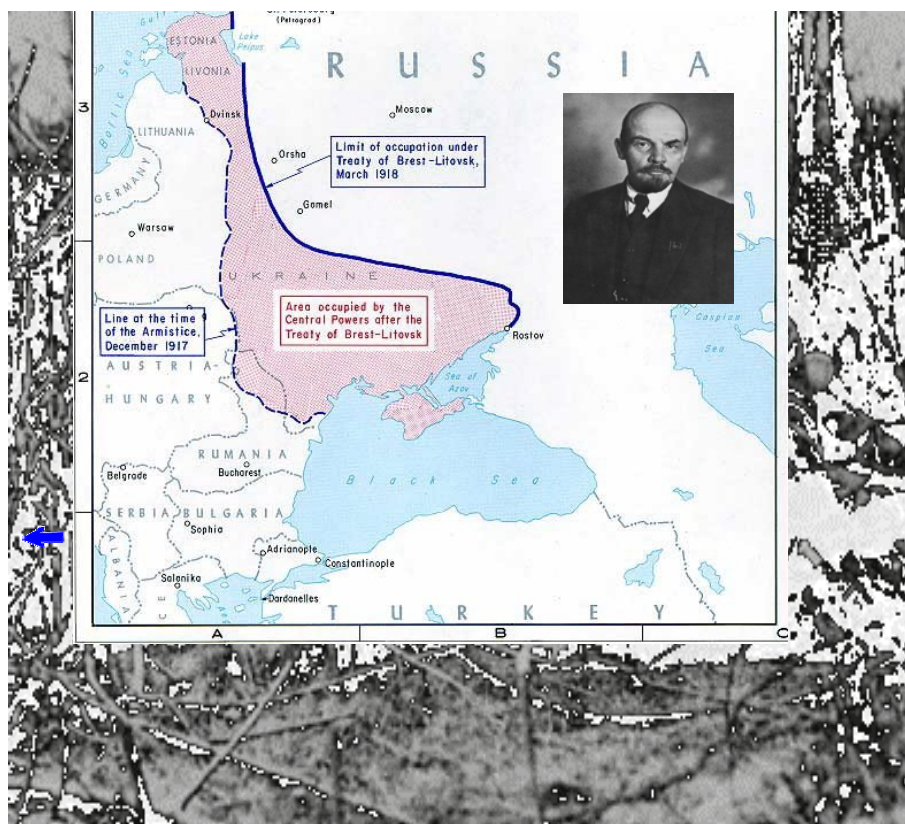

Russian Revolution

1. The ineffectiveness of czarist rule in Russia was a contributing factor to the Russia Revolution.
2. Russia's military failures contributed greatly to the Russian Revolution.
3. The Provisional Government established in March made some reforms but did not prevent the 1917 Bolshevik Revolution. With a few more reforms, it possibly could have.
4. The Provisional Government experienced chaos in the military.
5. Vladimir Lenin modified Marxism to fit the conditions in Russia.
6. The Provisional Government was no match for Lenin and the Bolsheviks.
7. In the civil war in Russia (1918-1920), the Bolsheviks had a clear advantage over the Whites.
