Kidblog.org is designed for elementary and middle school teachers who want to provide each student with their own, unique blog. Kidblog's simple, yet powerful tools allow students to publish posts and participate in discussions within a secure classroom blogging community. Teachers maintain complete control over student blogs. (Teachers create their account on the site, and add students as users to their account.)


Creating Your Teacher Account

1. Click the link: 
2. Complete the form. Enter your username, password, FCPS email address, the class name of your blog, and the verification code. Click **“Create Class”**.
3. Once your class is created, you will be taken to the “dashboard” where you can complete the following tasks: write a new post, review posts, review comments, view and edit user permissions, and modify the settings. (See picture of dashboard below.)
