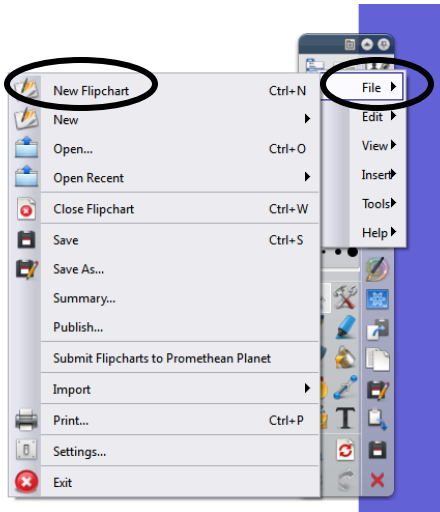


## Magic Ink

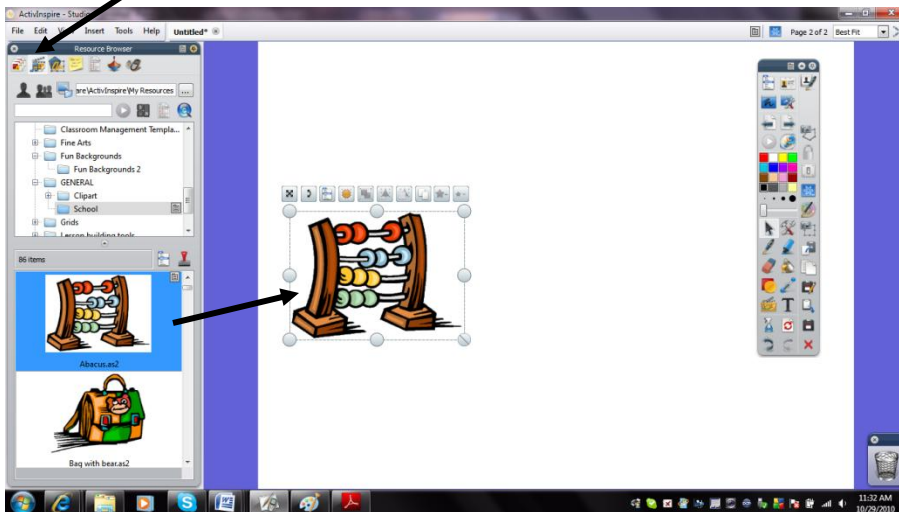
Magic Ink erases the top layer image on a Flipchart.

Practice:

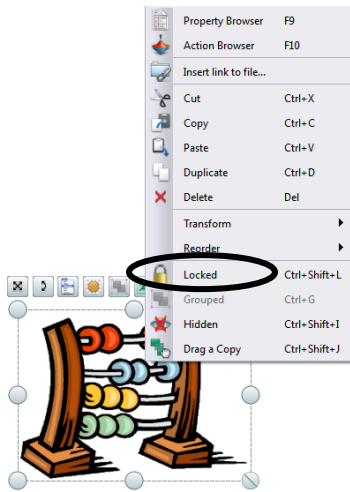
**1<sup>st</sup> Step:** Open a Flipchart page. File...New Flipchart



**2<sup>nd</sup> Step-** Go to Resource Library and drag an image to the page



**3<sup>rd</sup> Step.** Lock the image in place. There are many ways of locking an image. One way is right click the image and choose Locked.



**4<sup>th</sup> Step.** Using the pen draw over the image (easy way).

.....OR.....



Draw a shape over the image or insert a picture over the image

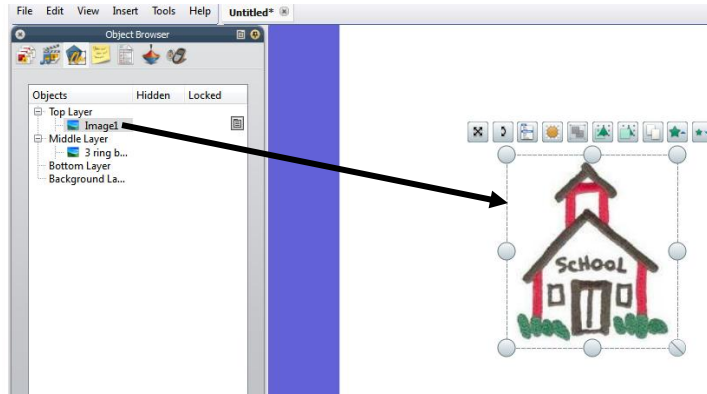
(To insert a picture. Copy the picture. Return to the Flipchart. Right click and paste.)

This image will be placed on top of the other image. It will be on the top layer. It will be the image that will be erased.

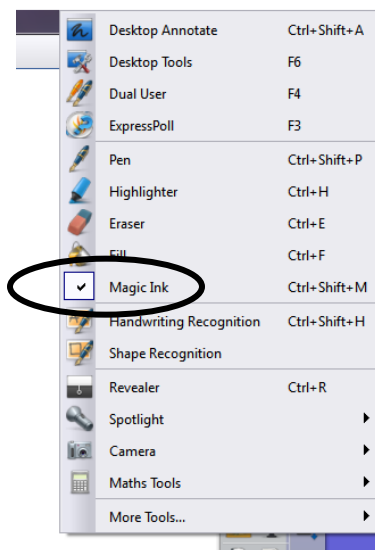


Go to Object Browser and make sure the image that you want to be on top is on the top layer.

Lock the image/ shape in place



**5<sup>th</sup> Step.** Go to tools and click the Magic Ink icon. Erase the top label to see the bottom layer.



**6<sup>th</sup> Step.** After you use the Magic Ink.

Click the undo button to return to the original screen.
