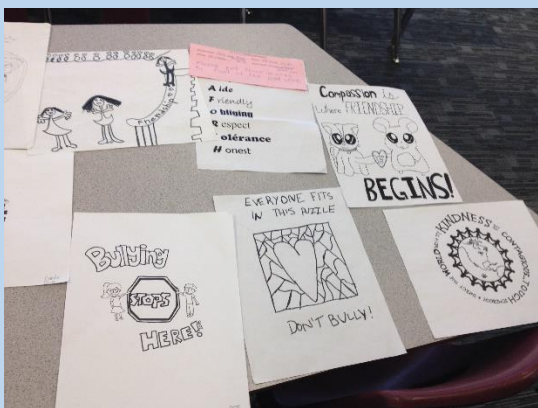


Seaforth Parent Advisory Council

Registration for Summer Session

The full Summer Session brochure is available on the website as of April 7 at www.burnabyccce.ca.

The Ministry of Education is providing funding for courses that lead to graduation and that are aligned with a significant number of learning outcomes specific to individual course curriculum.

To be eligible for "tuition free" courses students must:

- be a Canadian Citizen, permanent resident or convention refugee **AND**
- attended a BC school in the 2014-15 school year **AND** ordinarily reside in BC **AND**
- have a British Columbia Personal Education Number (PEN)

Elementary students are eligible to enrol in **only one** of these "tuition free" courses in Summer Session 2015. In addition, the district is also providing a number of course options that require a tuition fee.
