Proceeds for your returned containers will help support the many PAC funded programs at Seaforth.

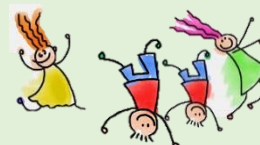
Make recycling easier with their drop off option and you will never need to sort those empties again.

- Step #3** Select how many bags you have and stick printed labels on each bag.
- Step #4** Place labeled bags on the Express Kiosk chute and you are done!
