We are	Respectful	Honest	Responsible
Beginning/End of Class	- Help get / keep learning time (minimize disruption or distraction) - Code switch to classroom mode	- Honor the bells	- Gather or put away supplies - Keep our room clean orderly
<u>Lab time</u>	- Gather and return supplies, clean up	- Doing only the activities planned	- Everyone is responsible for keeping everything safe
