by myself,” she adds.

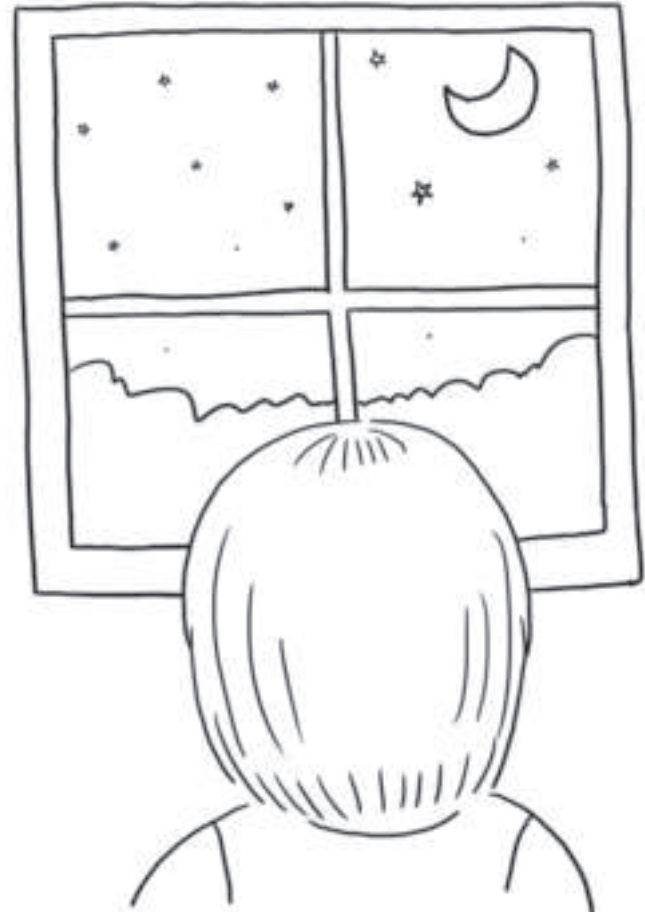


“Dinnertime!” her mom yells.
