A special moment is on Easter Sunday, when all the drummers are playing in Recinto Ferial and when the images of "La Dolorosa" and "El Resucitado" enter in the place, all drums become in silence, and when they are face to face, all drummers start playing again.



Apart from that, you can taste the typical Easter food like “mojete”, “empanadillas” or “panecicos”. And of course, you can’t leave Hellín without tasting Hellín’s candies that are made in local factories such “La Elisa” or “La Pájara”.
