

THE 2 RULES OF TILDES IN SPANISH

1. EVERY SPANISH WORD THAT ENDS IN **-S, -N** OR A **VOWEL** IS STRESSED ON THE SECOND TO LAST SYLLABLE.
2. EVERY OTHER SPANISH WORD (ENDS IN A CONSONANT OTHER THAN **-S** OR **-N**) IS STRESSED ON THE LAST SYLLABLE.

IF THE WORD DOES NOT FOLLOW THESE 2 RULES IT NEEDS A TILDE!!
