

SHHS Band Uniform Fitting/Alteration Guideline

- Unfortunately, this year we do not have the benefit of Men's Warehouse alterations department to complete most of our alterations. With that change, we will no longer be able to provide that service free to the band students. We will be looking for BASIC uniform adjustments.
- We do have options available for you:
 - 1) You may go to an alterations place on your own and get fitted at your cost.
 - 2) You may complete all needed alterations yourself or you may know someone who can/will complete all the adjustments for you.
 - 3) We will have an alterations service from Quick Grady Cleaners coming to the band room to fit our students.
 - They will take the uniforms to their shop, complete the alterations, and we will bring them back to the band room for students to try on for their final fitting. **(We will need you to add the estimated amount of money for the alterations to your student's account on the Sunday of registration day.)** If you pay more money that is estimated, we will add it to your student's charms account; if you owe more money, we will charge your student's charms account (if you have questions, please address during band camp registration with the uniform committee).
- ALL students should bring the parent signed form regarding alterations so the uniform committee will know how to proceed (will be attached to this e-mail or can be found on band website under the forms tab).
- We will be fitting during the first week of band camp (July 16-18). Seniors will be fitting on Monday from 11:30-1:00.
- Monday afternoon all new students that do not have a uniform will be fitted for one. Payment will be due before any alterations can begin. You may pay at the Sunday registration.
- Tuesday we will fit all Juniors and Freshman from 11:30-1:00.
- Wednesday we will fit all Sophomores from 11:30-1:00.
- Wednesday we will fit the Drumline and Front Ensemble from 11:30-1:00.
- ALL students should arrive to the band room in their band uniform on the day of their fitting. It is VERY important to have this process go as efficiently as possible.
- ANY student that does not show up with their uniform Monday-Wednesday of the first week of band camp will need to call the Quick Grady Cleaners store or any other alterations service to get their fitting completed.
- ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED TO BE FITTED WITH ALTERATIONS **COMPLETED BY AUGUST 10TH** (students will not march until their uniform has been cleared by the uniform committee and director to be worn).

The uniform committee will be available to check students off for their final uniform fitting every Monday/Wednesday/Friday after school from 3:00-3:30. Your student will receive their

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baldric once their uniform is completed. It is important to take care of this ASAP for the alterations companies to have time to complete them (must be completed by August 10th).
