

Photo Assignment

You will need to take pictures to illustrate the different photo composition techniques we have talked about.

Each person must take all of the pictures. A total of 12 pictures is required.

Each picture will be different with the exception of the Point of View pictures. The POV pictures will be the same setting taken with the 3 different points of view.

The pictures may be cropped and/or rotated to improve the composition.

All pictures must be in focus as appropriate for the composition technique being used.

The pictures will be printed 3 on a page. Each picture will be 4" x 6".

The pictures will be mounted on a poster board. You will need to make computer generated captions for each picture.

The required pictures are as follows:

- 1 Rule of Thirds
- 1 using horizontal lines
- 1 using vertical lines
- 1 using diagonal lines
- 1 "fill the frame"
- 1 macro shot
- 1 "framed" shot
- 1 shallow Depth of Field
- 1 deep Depth of Field
- 3 Point of View shots (all same scene)
 - 1 shoot from above
 - 1 shoot from below
 - 1 eye level

This project will be graded using the matrix on the back of this sheet.

Your name must be ON THE BACK of your posterboard.

"In focus" means the subject of the picture is sharp and clear as appropriate for the composition technique.

You are responsible for the final presentation including arrangement on the posterboard and appropriate captions.
