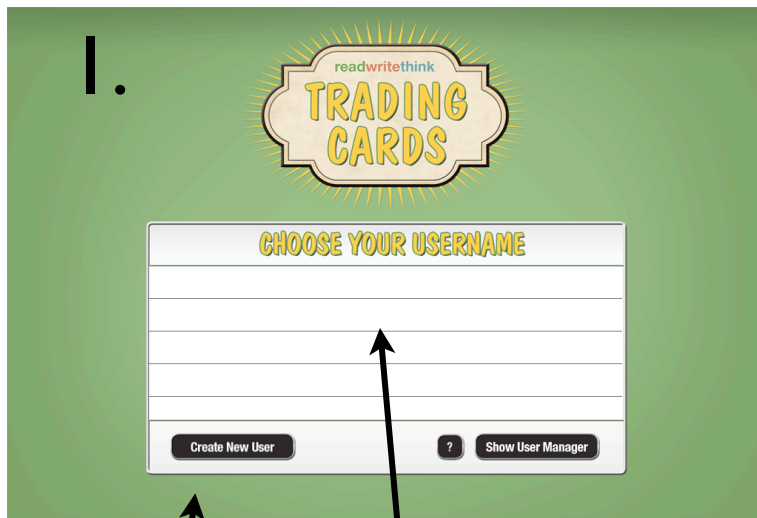
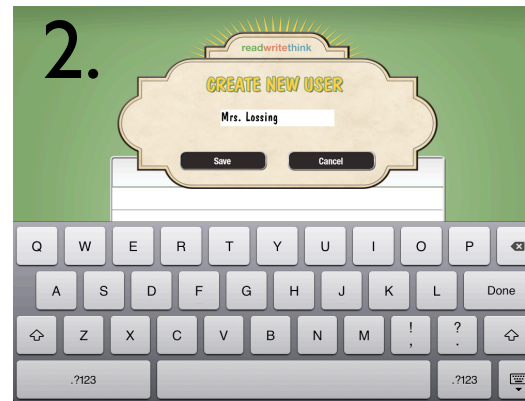

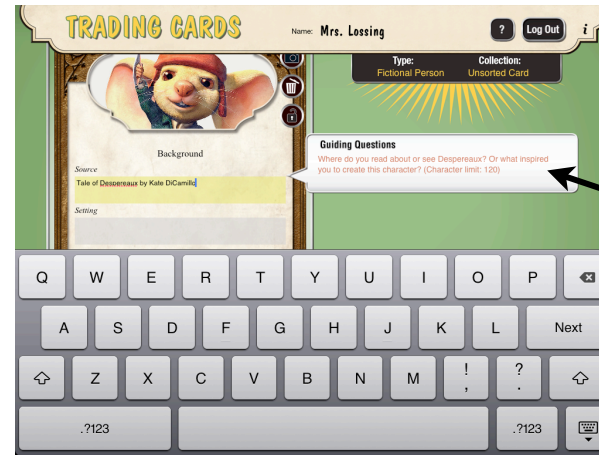

By tapping Change Card Theme, you get a choice of backgrounds



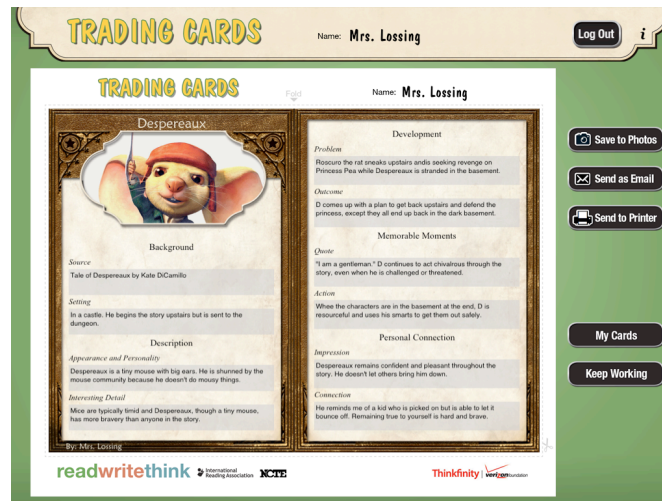
