Student Responsibilities:

Always be respectful to all and give your full attention to those that are supervising you.

1. School Rules are always in effect. If you create any problems for other students, skiers/boarders at RMR, RMR personnel or any chaperones, you may lose your privilege to attend the next trip or all remaining trips depending on the severity of the offence.
2. When we arrive at RMR a Courtesy Staff member will board our bus and talk about daily conditions, concerns and the Skiers/Boarder Responsibility Code. Always give them your attention and respect.
3. You must always ski /board with a buddy of your own ability and always have a meeting place in case you get separated. The bottom of the lift that you just rode would be a good meeting place. Always have a plan to reconnect if you get separated.
4. You will take MVC & NCC to the ticket window to receive lift ticket. Lessons & rentals will be printed on the lift ticket if you purchased the package. Remember to check your lift ticket for this information & if it is not correct tell a chaperone.
5. Those of you that have their own equipment or have skied/boarded at RMR may exit the bus first. Remember to always lock equipment, theft does occur and neither Hempfield Rec nor the chaperones will be responsible for lost or stolen equipment. We will escort those of you that are new to RMR to the ticket window, then to the rental area and off to the Discovery area where you will meet your instructor. Try to remember your instructor's name, that way if you have concerns about the instructor, good or bad, you can let us know their name and we can help to solve any problems.
5. Your lesson will last for approximately one hour. For those of you that have skied before your lessons will start at 4:30PM so be there five minutes early so you don't miss it. If you do you will have to make it up at 7:00PM. There is a large clock in the tower above the ticket/rental building which will help you with your time.
6. Those of you that are renting equipment from RMR should not get your skis switched with your buddy's because they are set up to release with your height, weight, ability and boot sole length. This could create a problem with you so remember the number on your skis.
7. There are lockers that you can rent for \$1. They are small but you may want to share them with your buddy. Keep in mind that every time you lock & open them it will cost you \$1. Have change; you will need quarters for the lockers.
8. Check in time will be between 6:30 & 6:45PM in the cafeteria level of the main lodge. At that time you can let us know if you are having any problems and we will give you your Meal Deal ticket if you ordered one. **Do Not Be Late!** If you do not show we will think you are lost and we will alert the safety patrol which could be **VERY SERIOUS!** We are always concerned about your safety! **If you show up late, you will lose your privileges on the next or all future trips.**

9. If you encounter any major injuries, have the safety patrol call the chaperone of your bus, so learn your chaperone's name. The chaperone will check up on you and if your injury requires that you are transported to a hospital, the chaperone will notify your parents and they will need to make arrangements to meet you there. The chaperones or advisor will not be able to escort you to or from the hospital.
10. Renters should exit from the slopes at 8:35PM to return your equipment, others should exit from the slopes at 8:40PM so you are not late for the return trip to Centerville. If you plan on stopping by the cafeteria for a snack for the ride home, you will need to quit at 8:30PM or sooner depending on how slow you are. All drinks must have lids. Buses will leave at 9:00PM sharp. Anyone late, will clean the bus after returning to Centerville and may lose their next trip on our bus.
11. You should review the "Skiers/Boarders Responsibility Code." It is important that you know it!
12. Before leaving Roundtop for return trip:
 - All drinks must have lids
 - All trash must be deposited into bus garbage bag during return trip
13. After arriving at Centerville:
 - Make sure your trash is deposited in garbage bag
 - Be careful when removing your equipment from the side compartment of the bus
 - Be careful when walking to your car in the Centerville parking lot.
 - If your parents are late arriving to pick you up, the advisor will need to discuss the issue with your parents.
