Charlotte Bronte



- * Charlotte Bronte was born in 1816.
- * She was the third of six children.
- * Her father was a clergyman.
- * She and her sisters endured great hardship at boarding school, Cowan Bridge.
- * As a result her two older sisters, Elizabeth and Emily die from consumption.

Charlotte Bronte



- * Her older sisters, Maria and Elizabeth, died young as a result of the poor conditions at Cowan Bridge.
- * Her mother died when the children were young.
- * During the era when she was writing, it was not considered an appropriate activity for women.

Charlotte Bronte

- * She and her sister originally published their work under the names Acton, Currer and Ellis Bell.
- * Their names were actually Anne, Charlotte and Emily.
- * *Jane Eyre* was published in 1847.
- * The book was highly successful.
- * Charlotte Bronte died in 1855
