Manager: Keeping group on track and checking time

Organizing Materials (including scissors, tape, rubber bands)

Ensuring that group workspace is clean at the end of each work day

Making sure that group has a plan (strategy) and castle/catapult are accurate

Gets supplies group needs and communicates with teachers

Researcher: Collects information on how to build and design castles and catapults

Shares information with group members and helps architect

Ensures castle and catapult are accurate

Researches recyclable materials and helps create list of needed materials

Architect: Draws design for castle and catapult using information from researcher

Determines what materials each part will be made out of


Ensures castle and catapult are accurate
