

## **Demonstrating learning in a good book reaction**

### ❖ Literal Thinking

- Ideas are right there and can be found by re-reading or re-telling the book.
- Summary, list of events, list of characters, etc.

### ❖ Interpretive Thinking

- Restates ideas from a book but includes ideas and interpretations from the reader.
- Includes connections the reader makes, emotions that were felt, interpretation of characters and their actions, etc.

### ❖ Critical Thinking

- Uses ideas from the book to make sense of the world around you.
- Connections you make from this story to another story, character or your own life.
- A lesson learned from the book.
- There isn't really a right or wrong but you are required to think about a deeper meaning that you feel the author intended to create.

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
