Literal Clues	Spelling Word
“to go” + “forward” = to move forward	p
“to break” + “between” = to break in between	i
“to draw or pull” + “away, apart” = to draw away from	d
“to move” + “forward” = to move an idea forward	p
“out” + “to break” = to break out	e
