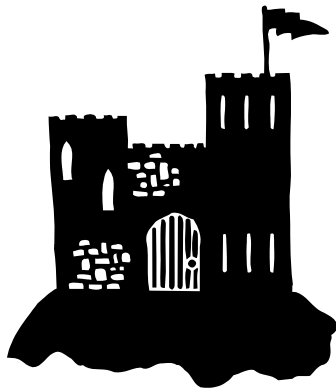


MEDIEVAL ARCHITECTURE

Based on a role of your choosing, you will design a structure for your job or your family. Your design needs to include a **top side view with the floor plan** along with **2 colored, floor level views**. One of these needs to be an **outside view** of the structure and the other needs to be from **inside the building**. Some structures to consider are basic houses, farmhouses, cathedrals, and castles. You will use the resources in the classroom and on the computer.

Medieval Architecture Checklist

- Look at resources for different structures
- Decide on structure and role
- On your white paper title the work with the type of structure and your chosen role
- Split your paper into 3 parts for drawing
- One drawing is the basic outline of the structure inside, taking off the roof
 - Include walls, windows, doors
 - Include a view of the land around your structure
- One colored drawing of the front, outside of the structure
- One colored drawing of one room inside the structure including any furniture, walls, doors, or windows
