<b>Lesson Name: Sticky Verbs</b>
<b>Topic of the Lesson: Difference between nouns and verbs</b>
<b>Age Range/Grade Level/Content Area: 7-8</b>
<b>Materials Required: Thinking minds, piece of paper, pencil</b>
<b>Time Required: 45 minutes</b>
<b>TEKS or objectives:</b> (21) Oral and Written Conventions/Conventions. Students understand the function of and use the conventions of academic language when speaking and writing. Students continue to apply earlier standards with greater complexity. Students are expected to: (A) understand and use the following parts of speech in the context of reading, writing, and speaking: (i) verbs (past, present, and future); (ii) nouns (singular/plural, common/proper); (iii) adjectives (e.g., descriptive: old, wonderful; articles: a, an, the); (iv) adverbs (e.g., time: before, next; manner: carefully, beautifully); (v) prepositions and prepositional phrases; (vi) pronouns (e.g., he, him); and (vii) time-order transition words; (B) use complete sentences with correct subject-verb agreement; and (C) distinguish among declarative and interrogative sentences.
<b>Introduction/Purpose: The purpose of this lesson is to learn the meaning and the use of verbs and also determine the difference between nouns and verbs.</b>
<b>Learning Activities/Step-by-Step Procedures:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Learn what a verb is, and how to use it.</li><li>2. Students will be required to participate in a activity by separating the nouns and verbs from each other.</li><li>3. Have them share what they learned in the end.</li></ol>
<b>Guided / Independent Practice:</b>
<b>Closure / Summary: Students will reflect the on what they have learned about verbs and the difference between nouns and verbs by writing down some that they learned.</b>
<b>Assessment / Evaluation: Student will correctly stick verbs and nouns in the right category on the board.</b>
<b>Relevancy: They need to use verbs and nouns to write papers, and sentences.</b>
