Factor	How it lead to the industrial revolution in Great Britain
Agricultural revolution	It leads to the Industrial revolution in Great Britain because there were more landowners that gave them more land. Because people got more land, the farmers started to experiment things. And the large landowners forced the poor, small owners to go to the city.
Economic freedom	Many people especially business people started to invest in manufacturing for new inventions.
Stable Government	Britain had a stable government because they had a wise structure for bank system. By banking system people were able to get loans from the bank and invest to manufacturing and new invention.
Transportation	During industrial revolution, water transportation developed. For instance, steam engine facilitation a network of canals, or cost of transporting raw materials more easily . Also, because of road transportation, even during bad weather, transportation could be made.
Textile industry	By textile industry people were able to get clothing easily.
