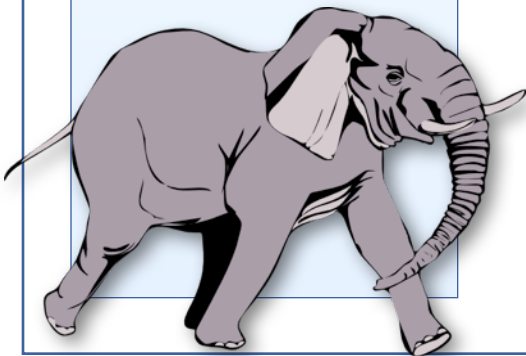

BEFORE THE TRIP

Wow! I can't believe I am really going to Africa! I heard it is little difficult because the not many countries are developed. But I think this trip will be FANTASTIC because I look at this as part of adventure, not trip. By adventuring, I can learn many different tribe's culture, their problems, and many other things! Korean Embassy has told me that some of the countries I am visiting often have thief who threat with weapons. I should be careful of that.

THINGS TO BRING

Since the trip is going to be an adventure, I decided to bring things that I already have so I don't waste my \$4000. Also, I know I have to walk, hike, run when I travel around, so I decide to pack really light so I don't have to carry a lot of stuffs. So here's the list of things I am bringing with me for my trip!

- Clothes- shorts, t-shirts, light jacket, sweatshirt, long pants and sleeve.
- Socks
- Towel (more likely "Sports Towel")
- 1 Sneaker and 1 Sandal
- Small size sleeping bag (it's very compact!)
- Flashlight
- Backpack & Belt bag (for carrying money, passport, and important documents)
- Camera (that is not really expensive- something that can be taken away...)
- Bu Mul Lie (버물리) those medicine for bug-bites
- Money!
- Sun block
- Sun glasses
- Ramen powder (According to people who have visited, there's ramen noodles in Africa!)



THINGS TO DO!

Visa!

SOUTH AFRICA- For South Africa, there is no need to pay for the visa because it is free.

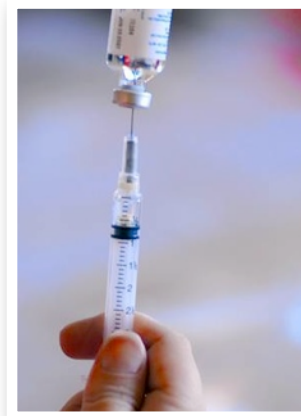
BOTSWANA- For Botswana, I had to get the visa before I leave Seoul. I had to fill out document that asks for visa, had to attach 2 passport photos, copy of airplane tickets. It usually takes 4 to 14 days for the visa but it took me 5 days. R50 for the visa (\$ 6.67)

ZIMBABWE- I only have to show them the airplane tickets, passports. I don't need to get the visa in advance. I got it in the airport. \$30.00 for staying 30 days or less

Vaccines! Shots! Pills!

If I knew I had to take medicines week before the trip and have many different shots, I would choose not to go. (Since I hate shots more than anything in the world!). Before I travel to South Africa, Zimbabwe, Angola, Botswana I had to get vaccines at least 4-6 weeks before the trip to allow time for the vaccines to take effect. I also had to take medicine a week before the trip so that I can prevent malaria. I was informed to take additional vaccinations since I am staying at Africa for more than two weeks. I found out that I had to get vaccinations for yellow fever because the government requires travelers and have to present a proof of yellow fever vaccination when I get there. Vaccines I had to get was **ROUTINE**, since I was not up-to-date

with routine shots such as measles/ mumps/rubella (MMR) vaccine, diphtheria/pertussis/tetanus (DPT) vaccine, poliovirus vaccine and others. Then, I had to get **HEPATITIS A or IMMUNE GLOBULIN (IG)**, which is one of the recommended vaccines for travelers who are traveling to those countries with high level of hepatitis A because the exposure can occur through food or water. I also had to get **HEPATITIS B** vaccination because I am going to a countries with intermediate and high level of endemic HBV transmission. (This is usually for people who might be exposed to blood or body fluids, have sexual contact with the person who have this, or having medical treatment.



However, the doctor recommended getting this just in case). I had **TYPHOID**, which is one of the required vaccination for travelers who are going to Southern part of Africa. This was especially for people who are staying in small cities, villages, or rural areas and staying with group of people because this might occur by food or water. Finally, I was also required to get **RABIES**, which is required for travelers who will spend a lot of time outdoors, especially in rural, involved with bicycling, camping, or hiking. This is especially for long-term travelers and people with significant risk of exposure with animals such as bats, mammals, and other kind of mammals.

For Angola, I had to get one extra vaccine, which was **POLIO**, because I received a primary series with Inactivated Poliovirus Vaccine.

I was able to get all of these vaccines in Gangnam Health Center around my house (서울보건소). I asked them to write document that has the dates I had the vaccine and the types of vaccination I received because without this documents, I might have some serious problem entering a country. The doctor gave me prescription for large amount of medicines I can take to Africa so that I can use them during my trip or I can give to people who needs them. The doctor told me the symptoms of the Malaria and she told me that with one dollar, I can get it checked at a hotel. She told me to get it checked at a hotel because it is most accurate place. Since I have the health insurance, I paid ₩110,000 for everything.

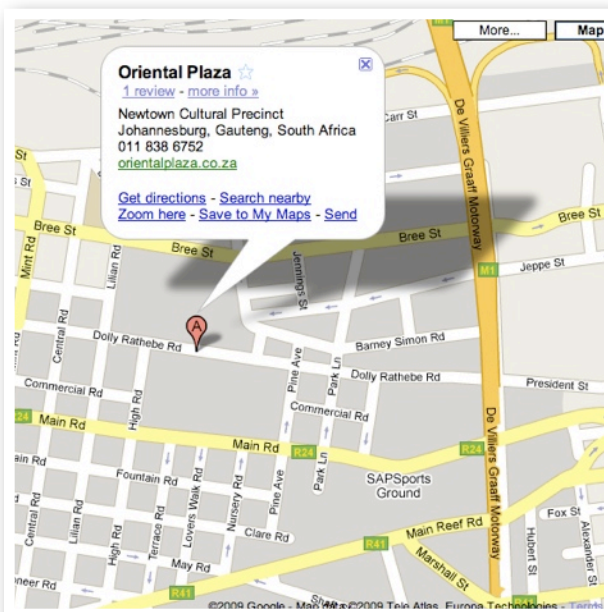
Arirang Restaurant

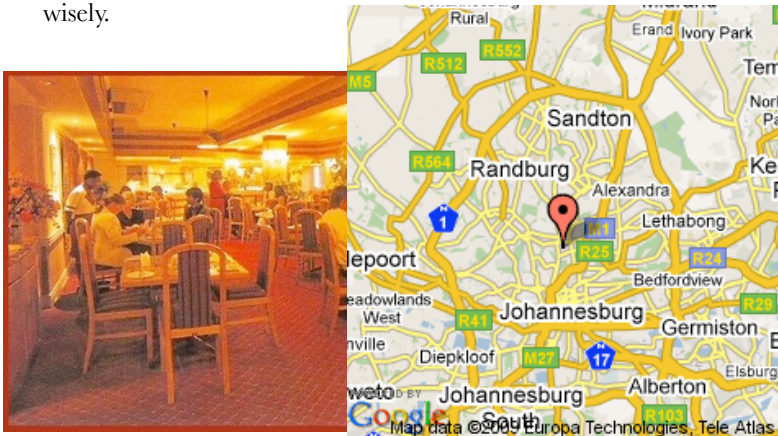
DAY 3 (DECEMBER 8TH)

Shona Soft-Stone Carving

Zimbabwean stone sculptures are seen today began during the late colonial period of the 1950's and 1960s. During this period, the artists and artisans depicted many of the traditional Shona and other tribal spiritual myths such as the Nyaminayami.

This Shona Soft-Stone Carving is commonly referred to as Rapoko stone in Zimbabwe. Steatite is a natural soft stone that falls under the general category of soapstone. Rapoko is found on every continent in the world with the possible exception of Antarctica. Rapoko is a natural mineral, prized since ancient times for its durability, workability, beautiful character and ability to retain and radiate heat and resist chemicals.

Artists for Shona Soft-Stone Carving really burnish and smooth the work. In keeping with the painstaking, somewhat "old fashioned" hand crafting techniques used to create the finished stone carvings and sculptures, the heating of semi-finished carving is most often done as shown.

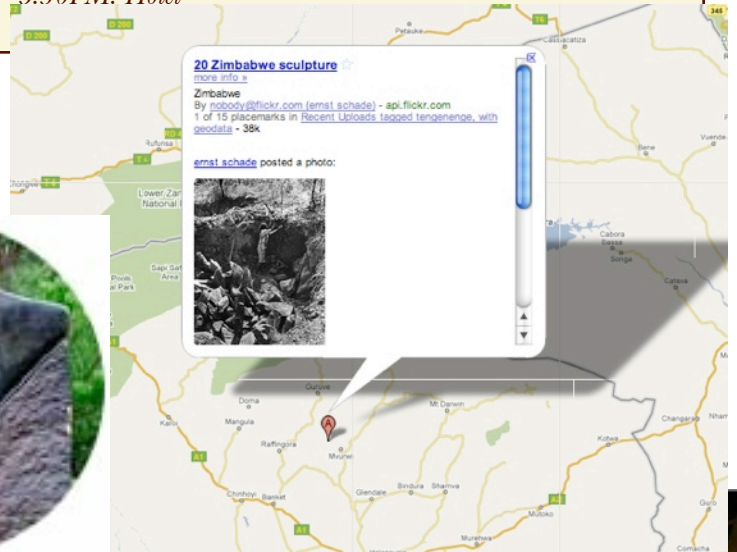

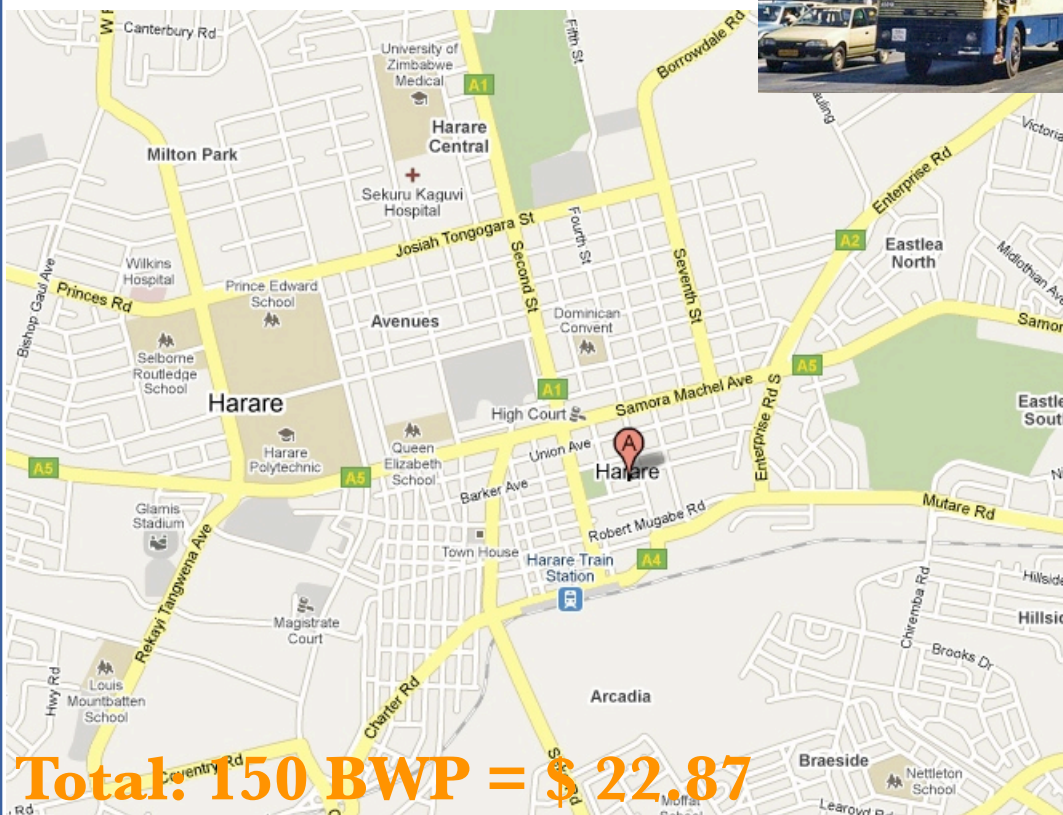

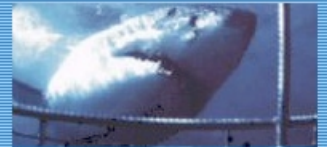
Since I loved sharks and all those species in the water, I loved to swim and I learned scuba diving in order to experience/see the under world.

On the way to the diving point, I had to sign this paper saying that I won't sue them even if I get killed by Great White. This is mandatory step to go through before diving because they don't want to deal with any major accidents. When we arrived at the diving point, I helped to throw tuna fish and blood all over the ocean. This is because we need attract Great Whites to the diving point. After few moment, fake seal shaped wood-board is tossed at the ocean. This is to trick sharks.

After a while, I see some triangle shaped fins coming towards the boat and circle around the food. This is the time when people quickly dress up into diving suit and listen to the instructor. I was in the 3rd group, which means that I go after first two teams. Since the cage is little small, not many people can go into the cage. The moment I saw a Great White was amazing. It was humongous! The sharp teeth shaped like blazers made me scared but the experience was fantastic.

After I got out from the cage, I ate small snacks provided by the people on the tour. It was really delicious! Maybe because I was tired and hungry. Although I went to some Shark Diving when I lived at New York, the shark size is way different. When I was at New York, I shark dived in Montauk, the place where numerous shark attacks happened and the setting of Jaws movie. Since the water temperature of Montauk is little colder than Cape Town, the Great White Sharks were really big compare to the one I saw in New York.

Second day was almost similar to the first day but I also went to night dive. Night dive means scuba dive at night. Night diving was also amazing! I was able to see colorful creatures, some species I never seen before. Although I always looked around myself and I tried to stay in the group, I still had some fear.

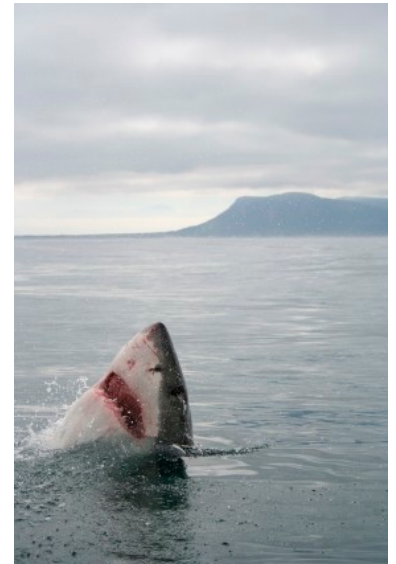

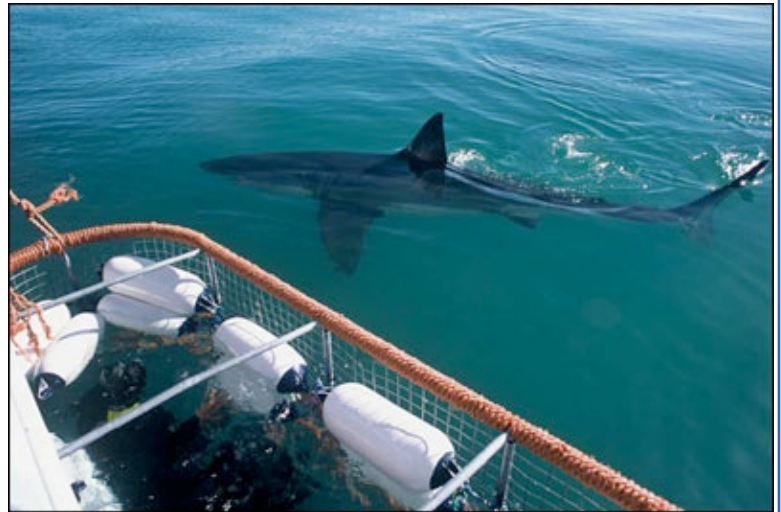

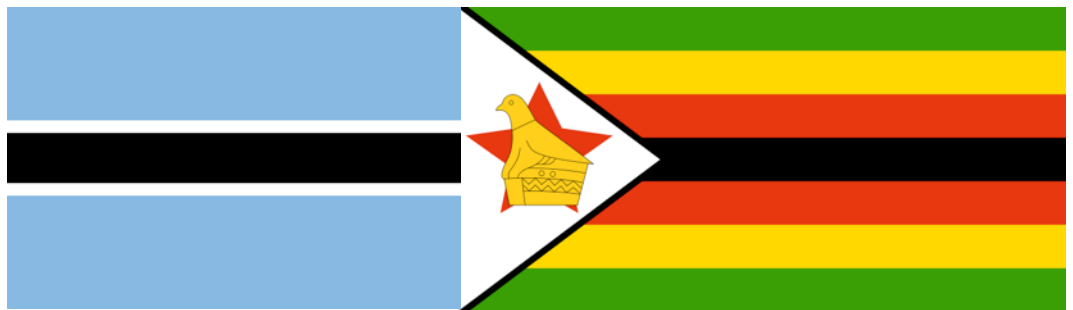
