

Timeline- European Theater



1934- Hitler puts lots of efforts into growing and extending his military. His Target was the newly formed countries.

1936- March 7, German Troops occupy Rhine Land

1939-

- 23 August, Nazi Soviet Non-Aggression Treaty. a.k.a Nazi Soviet Pact.

- 1st of September, Hitler gains control of Poland. Britain and France declare war two days later.

- Sept 3~ May 10th-The Phony War. This resulted in the battle of France.
- Invasion of Czechoslovakia.

1941-

June 22 ~December5, Operation Barbarossa. Plan to take over Soviet Union. As a result, Germany gains territory but fails to take over the whole of Soviet Union.



1945-

- Dec 16 1944- Jan 25 1945, Battle of the Bulge. German operational failure.

- May 7, Hitler commits suicide

- May 8, V-E day. Known as the victory in Europe day. Nazi Germany surrenders.



1933- 30th of January, Hitler becomes the chancellor



1935- Hitler breaks the Treaty of Versailles by remilitarizing

1938- 12 March~13 March, Germany announces the Anschluss with Austria.



1940-

- April 9, Denmark and Norway was Invaded
- May 6~June 4th, Battle of Dunkirk. Resulted in German victory.
- May~ June 5th - Germany began to attack France and resulted in the fall of France.
- Winston Churchill becomes the prime minister of Britain.
- July 10~ October31, The Battle of Britain. Included battles between air forces. As a result, Operation Sea Lion was delayed.
- 17th September, Germany was supposed to launch the plan, Operation Sea Lion, However, due to German lost in the battle of Britain, the operation never carried out.



1942-

- August 23 ~ February 2 1943, Battle of Stalingrad. Germany and it's allies plan to take over the city of Stalingrad. Resulted in Soviet victory and huge number of deaths.
- October 23~ November 4, Second battle of El Alamein. Axis Victory.
