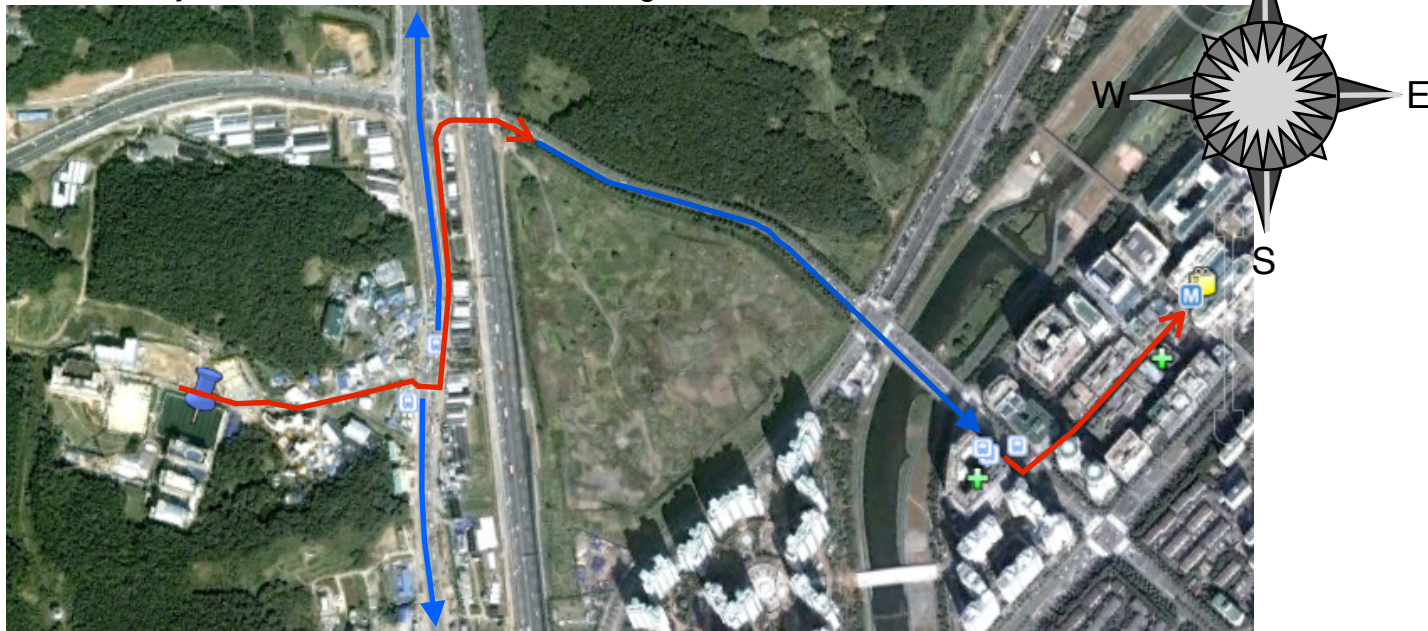


KIS Must Move!

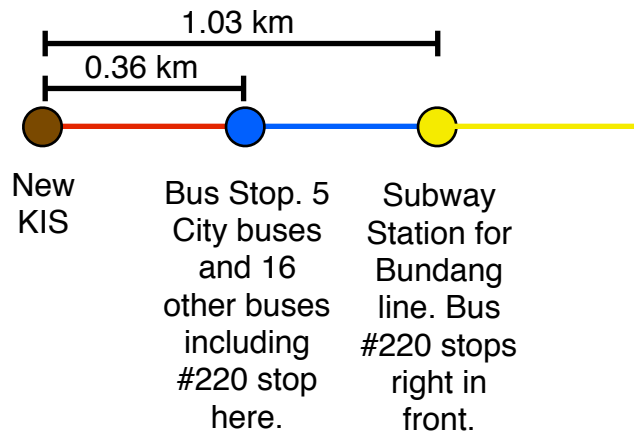
New Location for KIS

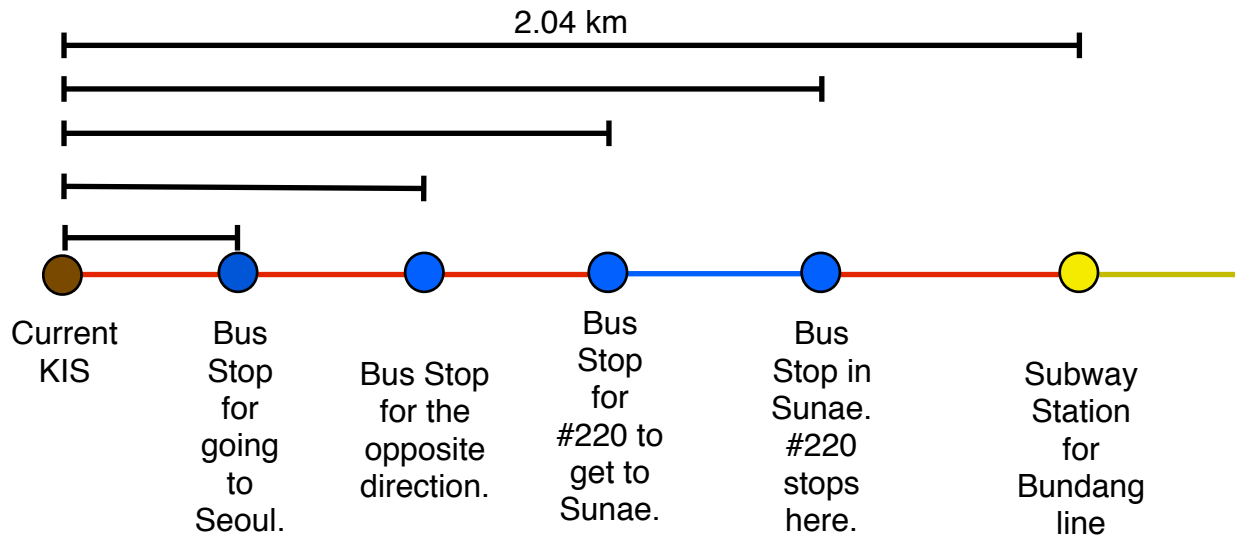

The ground are advantageous in almost every way, the grounds currently under construction alone cover up to 300m² of space.
