



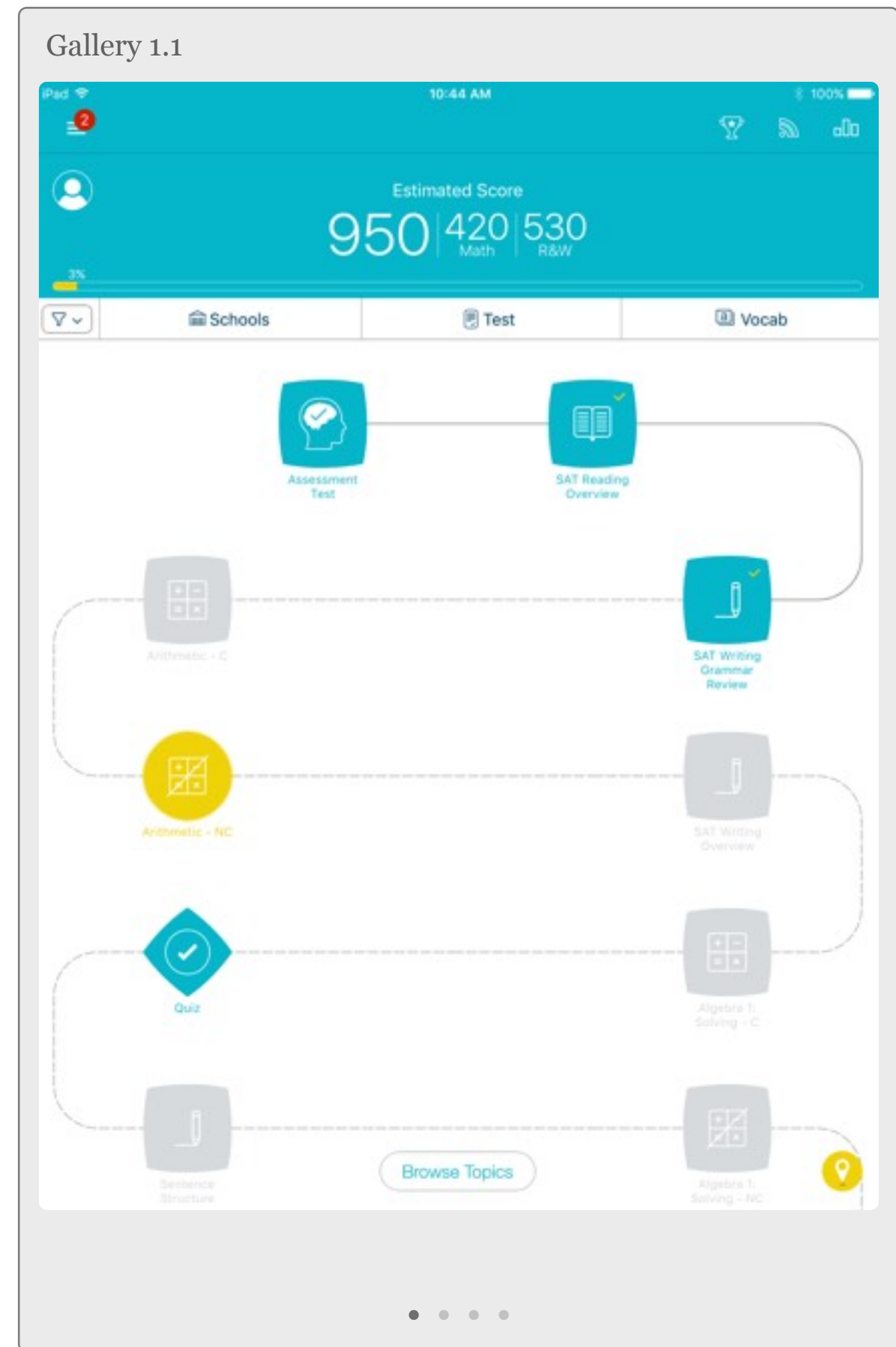
Ready4 SAT???

This is an app that helps students practice for the SATs. It had flashcards with information that students can read through.

It also breaks the test into just Math or just English, so if a student knows they need to work on one thing they don't have to trudge through everything else to get there.

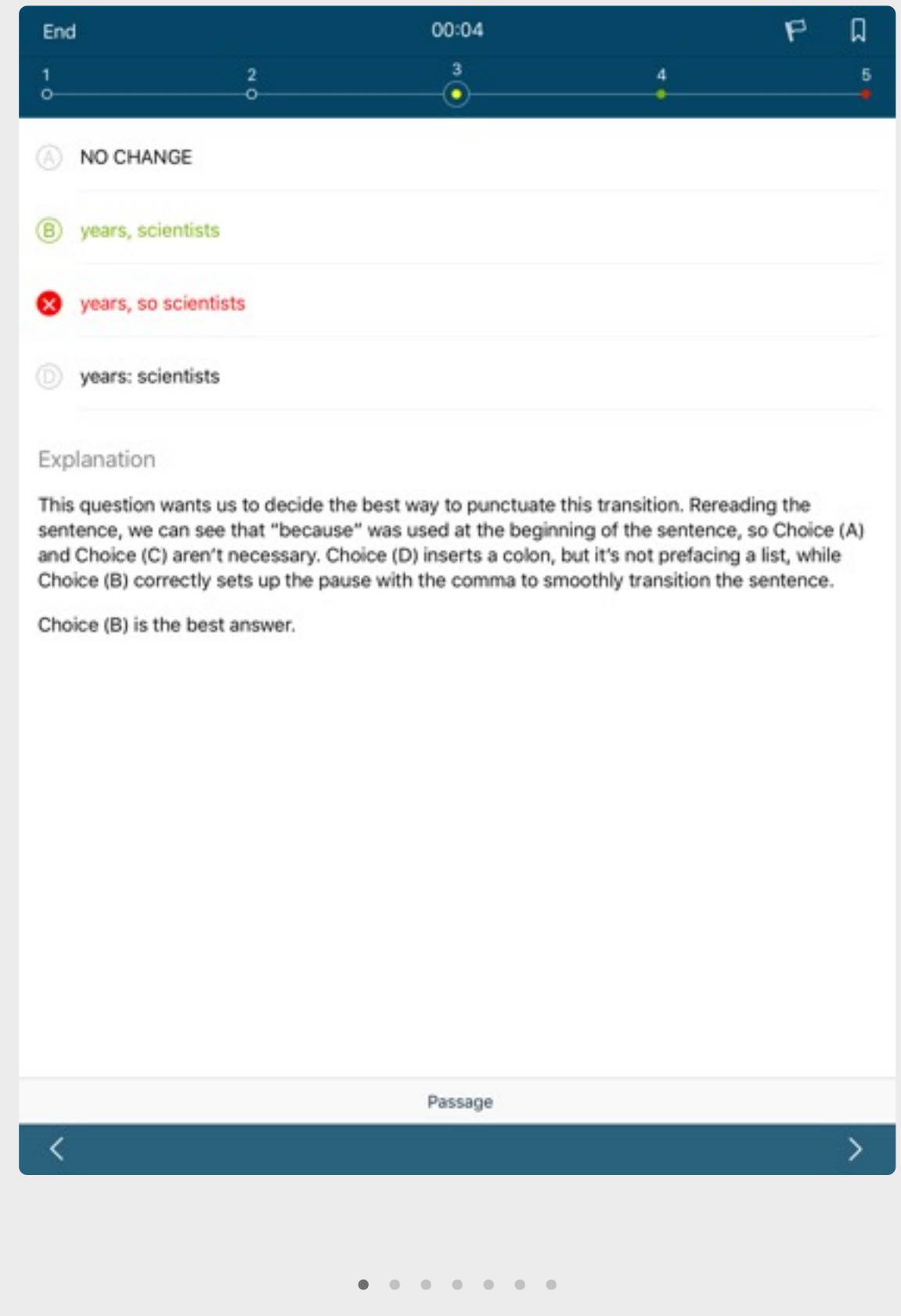
The Features

The app also projects an estimated SAT score based on your answers. Of course it's not guaranteed, but still cool to see.

There is a section where you can look up schools you want to go to and see if they match up with your projected score. The downside to this feature is that only schools that use the app are included.

GALLERY 3.1 The SAMR Model

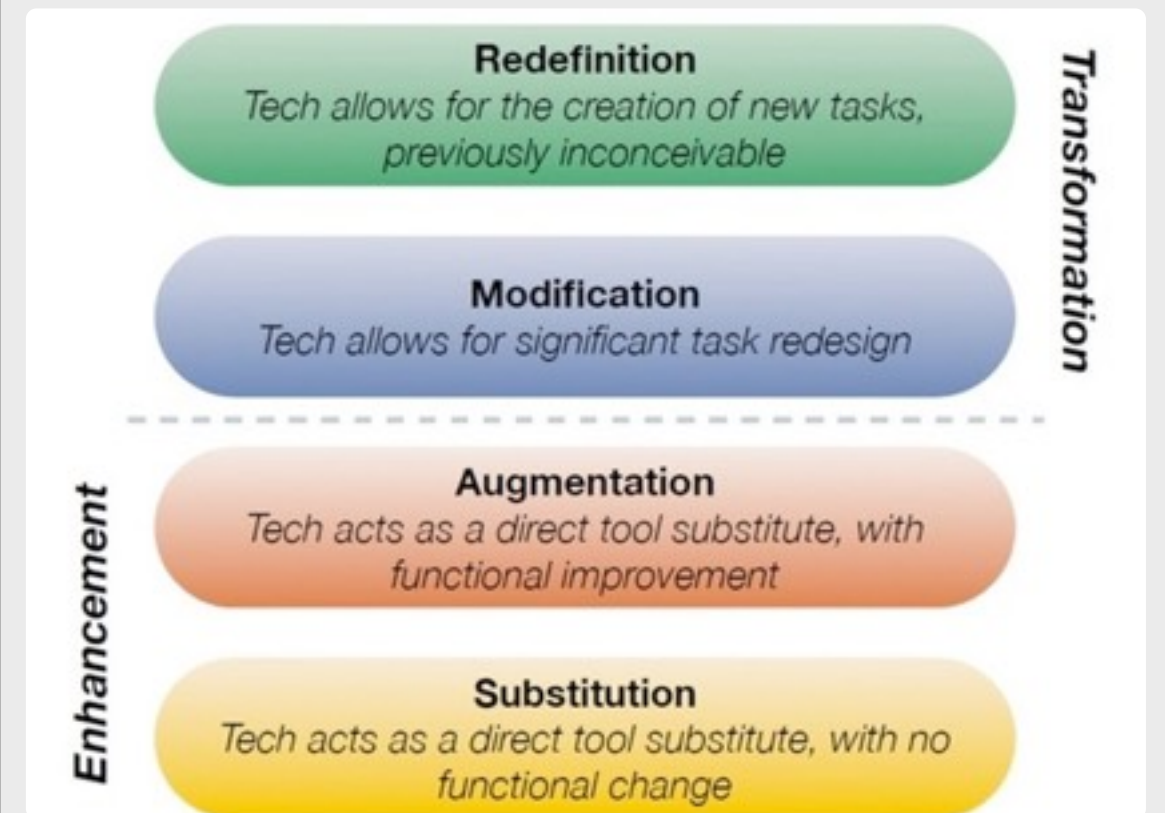
