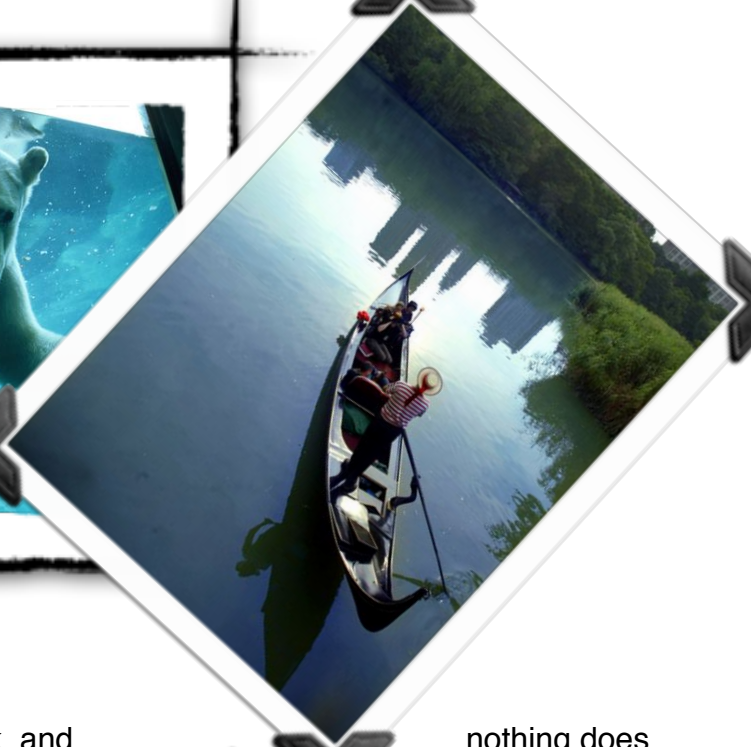


A Place I want to visit
