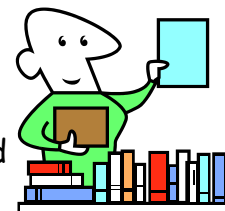

Chemical Reactions – An experiment to try at home if you have time.

#### **Invisible Ink**

1. Pour a tablespoon of lemon juice onto a small plate.
2. Dip your finger or a paintbrush in the juice and draw a picture on thin paper.
3. Leave the paper to dry.

Your picture will be invisible, but if you rub the side of a wax crayon over the paper, the picture will appear. WHY? Lemon juice is an acid. The acid breaks down particles in the paper. You can't see the change until you rub a crayon over it.
