

How To Learn My Spellings

Over the next 3 weeks you have spelling words to learn for the SPELLATHON.

Here are some tips to help you learn your words:

SAY the word – say the syllables if there are more than one.

STRETCH the word – work syllable by syllable sounding out the word.

SPLIT the word – split the word into the different syllables if there are more than one.

WRITE the word parts you sound out,
chunk it down into smaller parts.

CLARIFY the word – what does it mean?

MAKE A SENTENCE using your word – make it fun to help you remember the word.

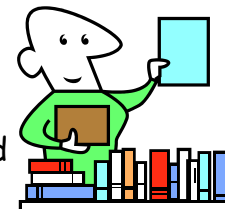
Use the grid to create your own word search. Swap yours with a friend who is learning the same words.
