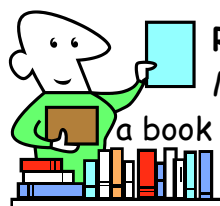


In class we have talked about how we want to be active learners. What we want, what we need and how we will achieve success in Room 4.
