


Maths



WORD FIND

CREATE A FAIRY TALE WORD FIND

Pick a Story Path

A good story has an interesting setting (where the story takes place), well described characters (people or animals) and an exciting plot (what happens). A story is usually about the characters solving an unusual problem.

SETTINGS
