


Middle Team Newsletter – T2

Welcome

Dear Parents / Caregivers

A warm welcome back to Term 2.

As always we are excited about the activities we have planned for students this term. The teachers enjoyed meeting with many of you at our Parent / Teacher interviews. We appreciate your support and look forward to our students making further progress this term.



Term 1 Topics

Our main topic for this term will focus on **Science**. Students will investigate the physical and chemical properties of common materials and changes that occur when they are mixed, heated or cooled through our work on “**Change – Fizzing and Foaming**”. This will involve students observing, describing and experimenting with different materials. We have included a small cost in the activity fee to cover the purchase of many of the materials required.

In addition, as part of our literacy programme, students will identify and apply the key features of Narratives. The students will examine the features of narratives and how to create exciting stories that include interesting characters and settings. In week 3, 16 May, we will be sending out the ATHON sheets. This year the focus is on General Knowledge and learning the facts will be included as part of weekly Home Learning.

Our numeracy strand will focus on statistics and probability, with students creating and displaying survey data. Students will continue developing number strategies through problem solving tasks.

Our Autumn sports programme continues with a focus on large, team ball games such as hockey, netball, touch, mini ball and soccer. These will take place on Wednesday afternoons. We would ask that your child wears the appropriate clothing for these lessons.

We would encourage you to continue to support weekly home learning and to help students learn basic facts and times tables at home. Home learning also includes students working on Mathletics and other online activities that your child's teacher has set up. Home Learning will come home on Monday and is due back on Friday. Good attendance will also be necessary as the teachers continue to assess and monitor your child's learning.
