Write their name and what the certificate is for. Put it in the mailbox for Friday afternoon. Your teacher will put out paper if you need it. You may use a computer to create a certificate

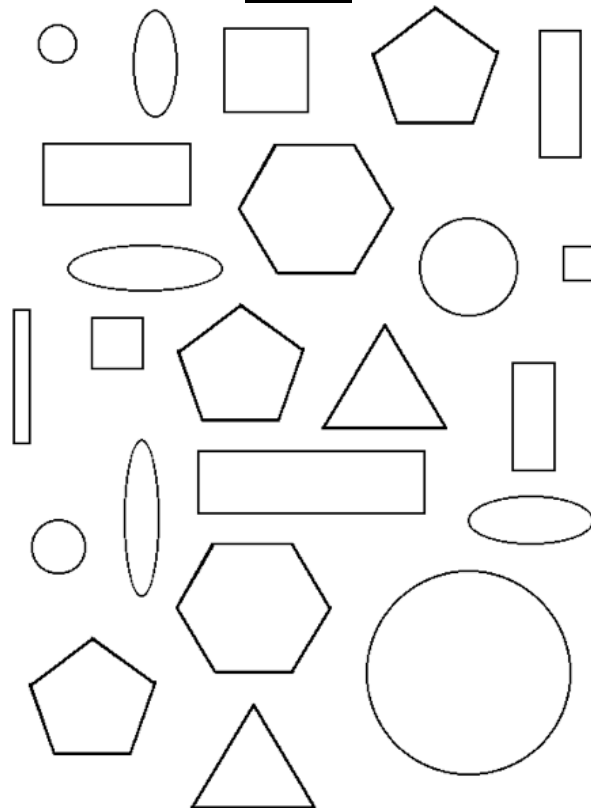
