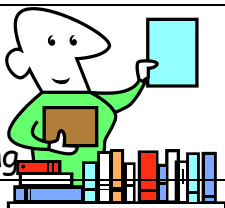


Reading Log

You should be working on your MATH - A-THON Learning sheets. A good way to learn the tricky ones is to make a FLASH CARD

FLASH CARDS - some examples

$$\boxed{5 + 6 =} \quad \boxed{7 + 7 =} \quad \boxed{8 - 5 =} \quad \boxed{10 - 3 =}$$

Write the fact on one side and the answer on the reverse.

Flash cards are good for keeping up your number skills and for playing games with a buddy.

Make up a set of flash cards that you can bring to school on Friday and use to test a buddy.

Look in your activity boxes for examples of flash cards if you are not sure of what to do.
