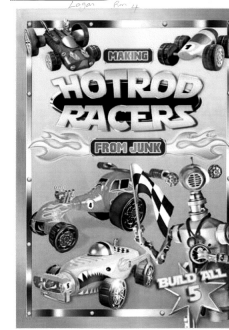
## From the teachers:
