You will give a presentation to the class about your family during your childhood. The objectives are to describe your family and to use the vocabulary and structures to express meaning in Spanish. You may bring in a picture of your family, but you may not have anything written down for use during your presentation. Remember that you are describing and talking about habitual repeated action in the past rather than one-time actions. Be sure to talk about 5 family members, including yourself – at least one female and one male. Describe each family member, tell about their likes/dislikes and their activities. Use a variety of sentence structures (singular, plural, negative, reflexive, 2-verb construction).
