

Weekly Outside Reading Homework Requirements

Your Spanish homework is to read 30 minutes of Spanish a week and write down any and all words that you recognize or want to learn. “There is overwhelming research showing that recreational reading in a second language is a powerful means of improving grammar, vocabulary, spelling and writing ability - and it is far more effective and far more pleasant than traditional instruction. People acquiring a second language have the best chance for success through reading” - Stephen Krashen, PhD

Throughout the trimester there will be 10 Outside (of class) 30 minute reading assignments that you will be required to do. You will report this homework each Monday.
