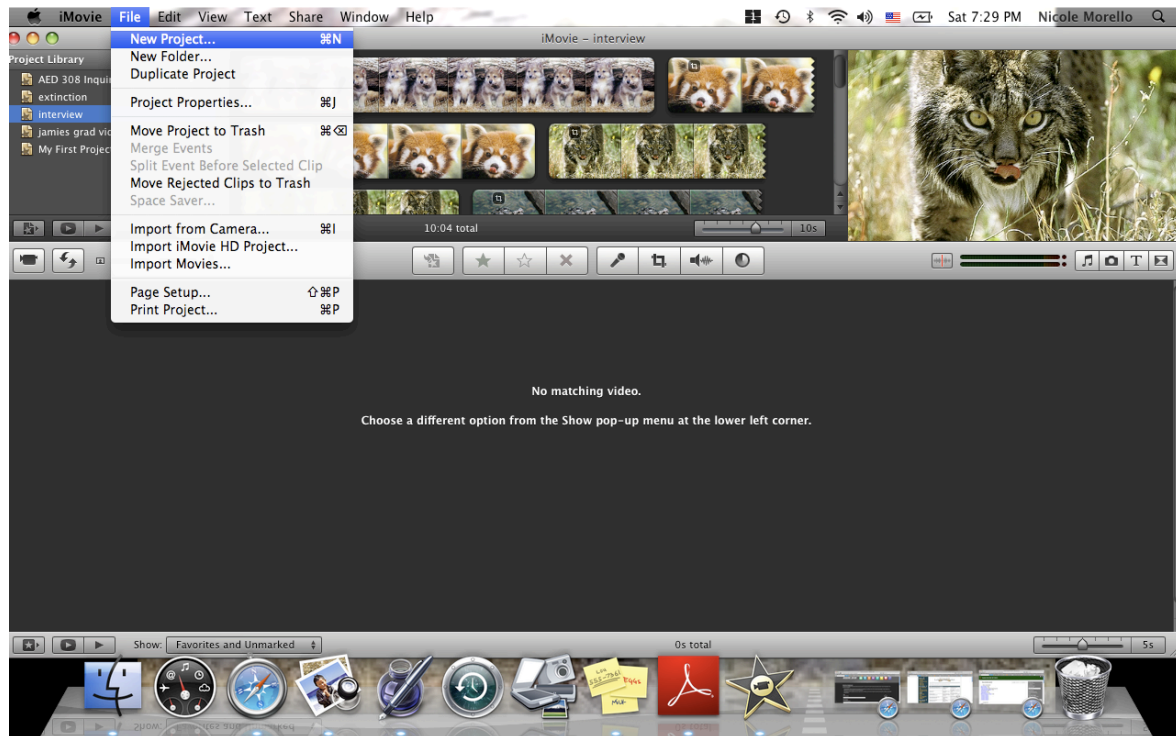
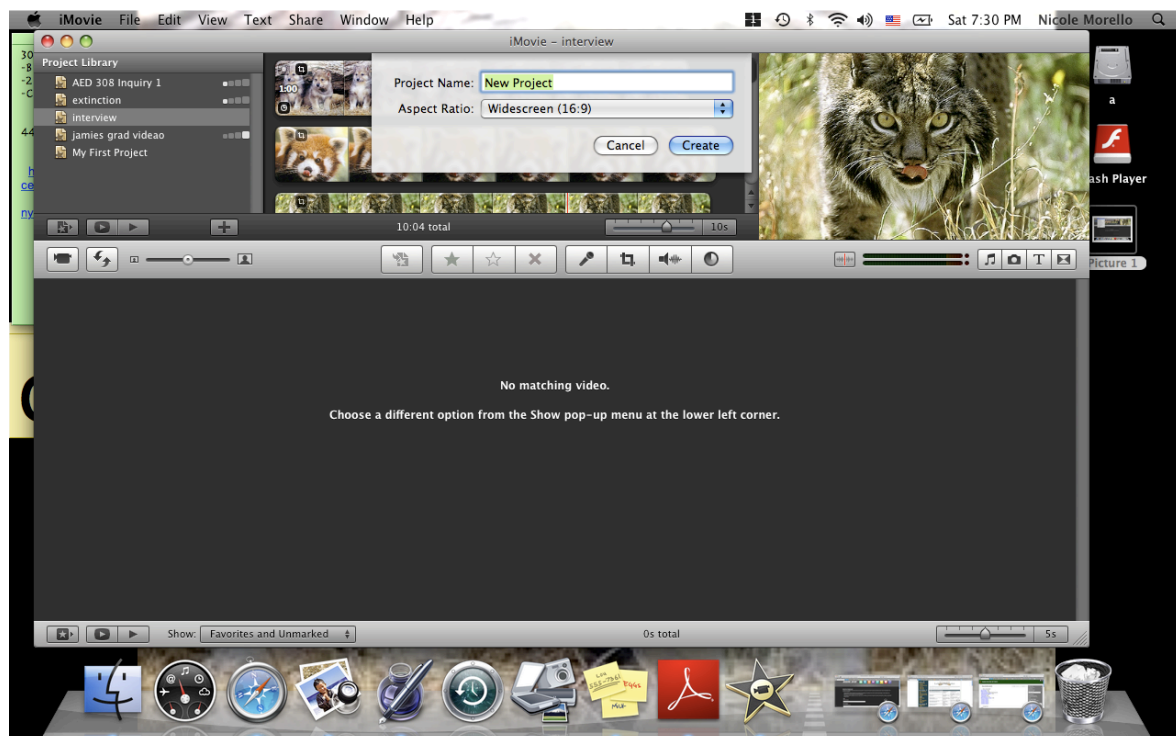


A Tutorial on how to use iMovie for Macs.

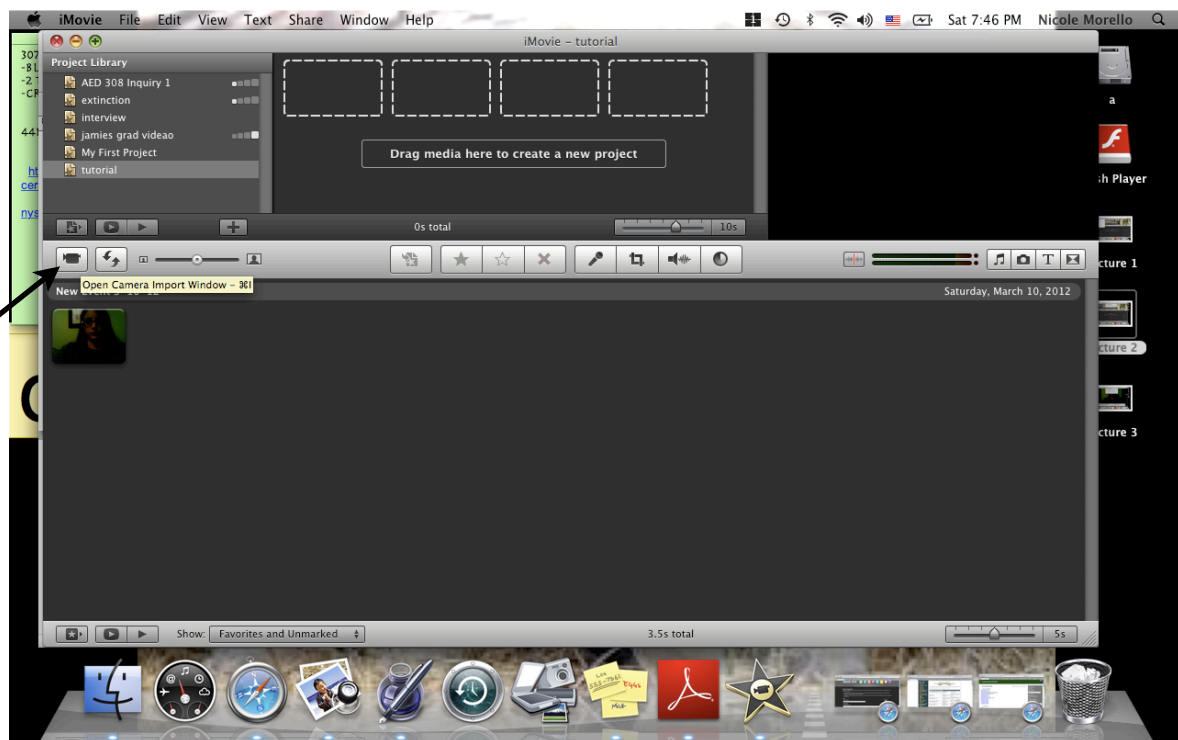
1. Go to your Finder.
2. Go to applications and scroll till you find it, or type “iMovie” into your search box.
3. Once iMovie loads, go to the File tab at the top left of your screen, and click New Project.



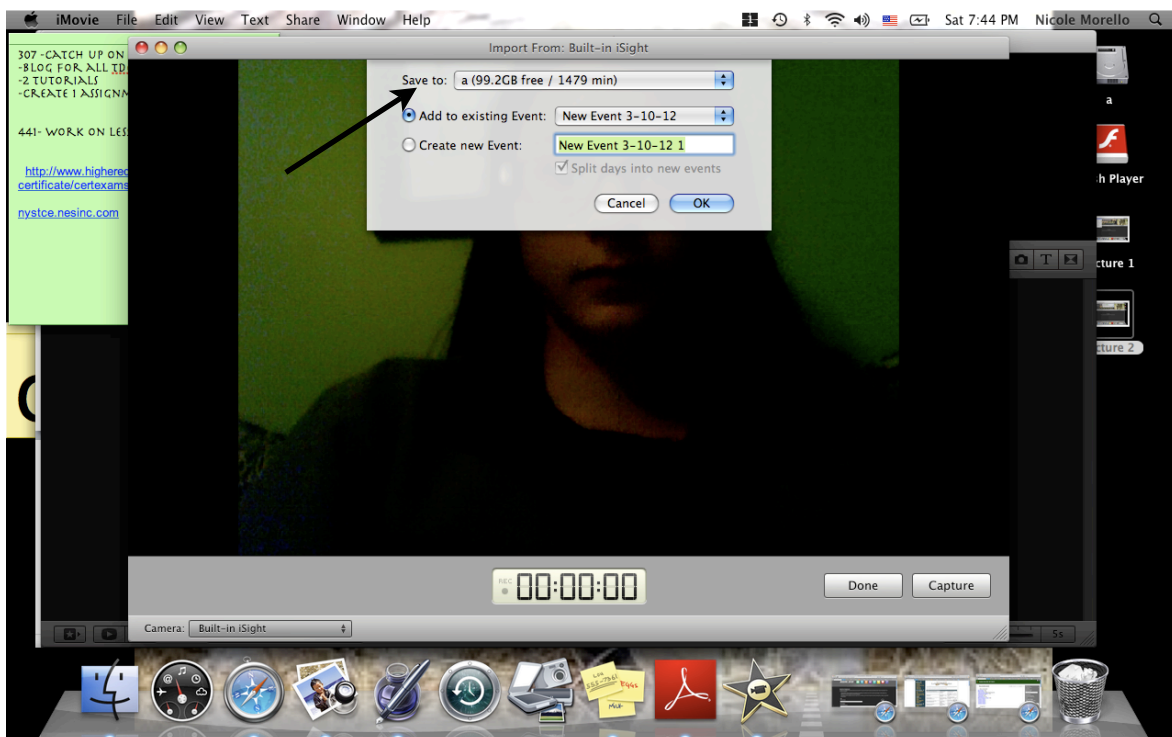
4. Once you click New Project, you will have to enter the name of your Project. I named mine tutorial for simplicity's sake.



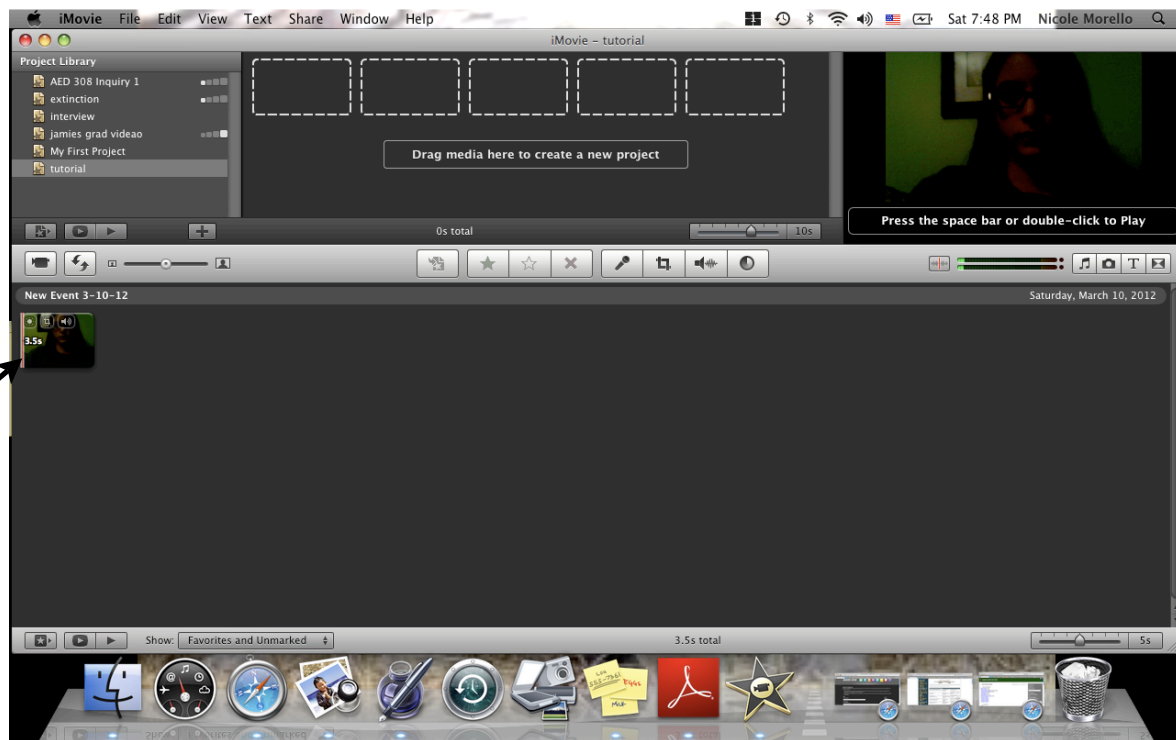
5. If you want to record video to add to your iMovie, click the camcorder symbol to the left.



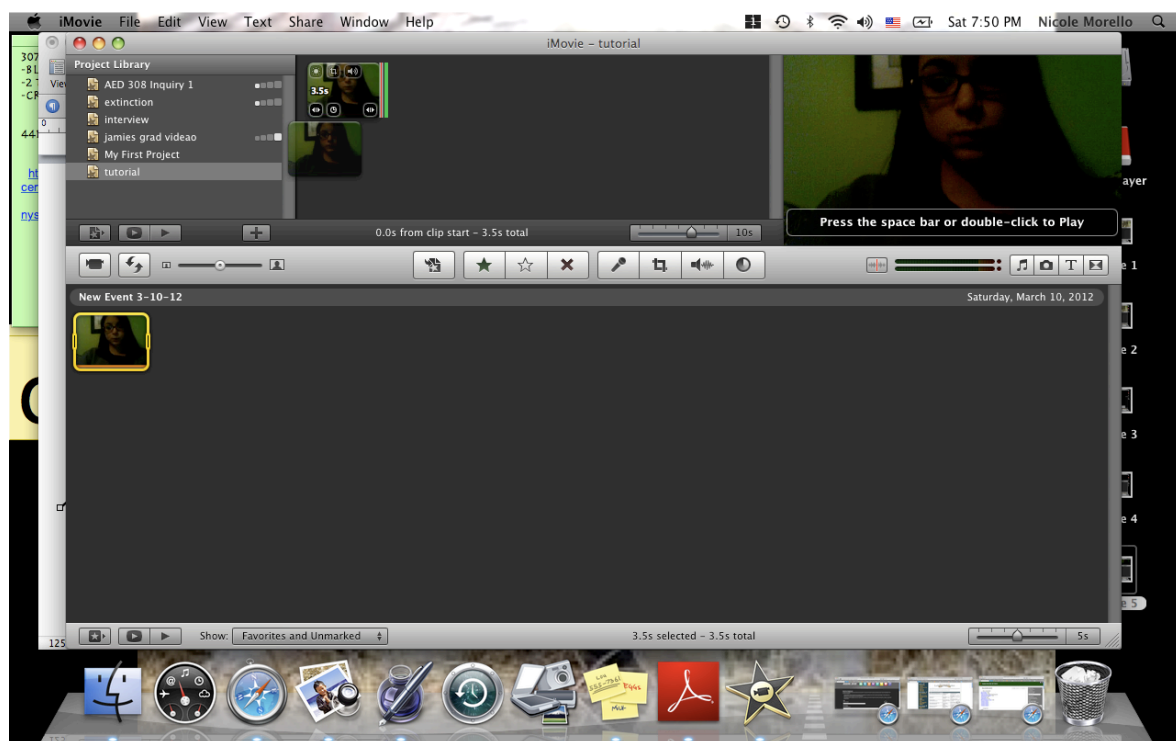
6. Once you click on this, a box will appear, and you will want to click on the “add to existing event.” Hit OK. This will then record your video. Hit stop once you are finished.



7. Once you have finished recording, you will be brought back to the main page for iMovie. Your clip will appear to the left.



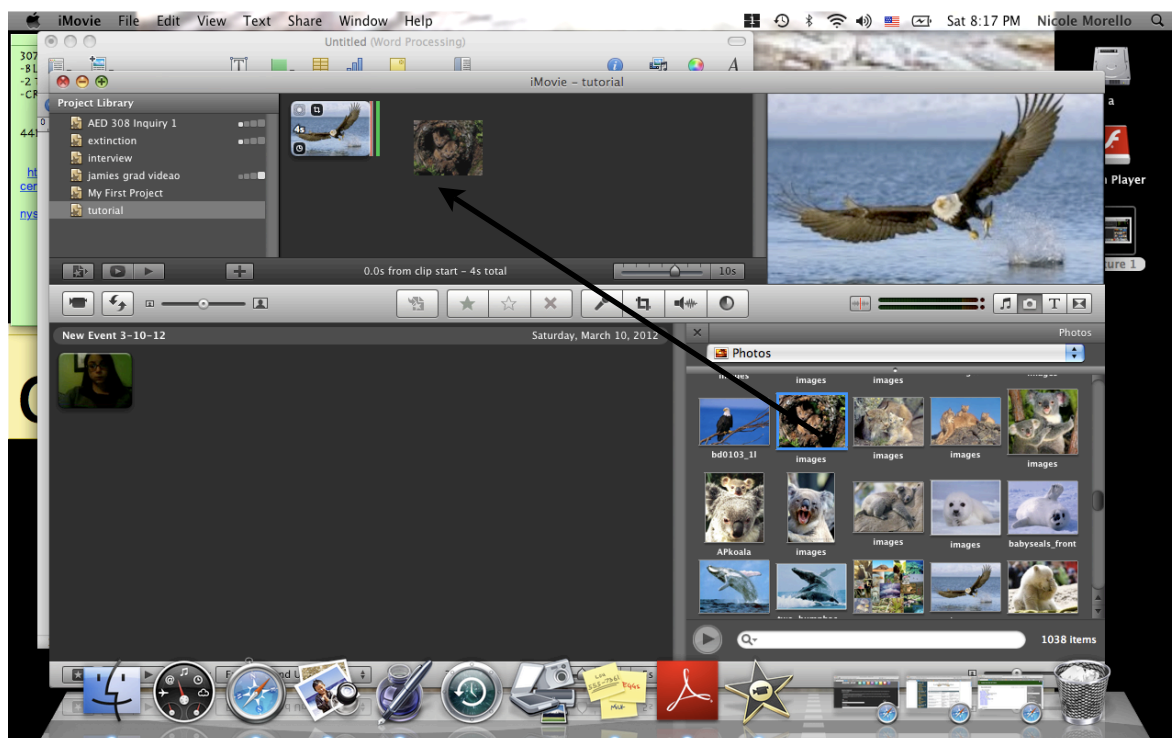
8. You then need to drag your clip to the above outlined boxes. This will be the first set for your movie.



9. In order to add pictures from your library. To the right there are four icons for music, pictures, transitions, and formatting.

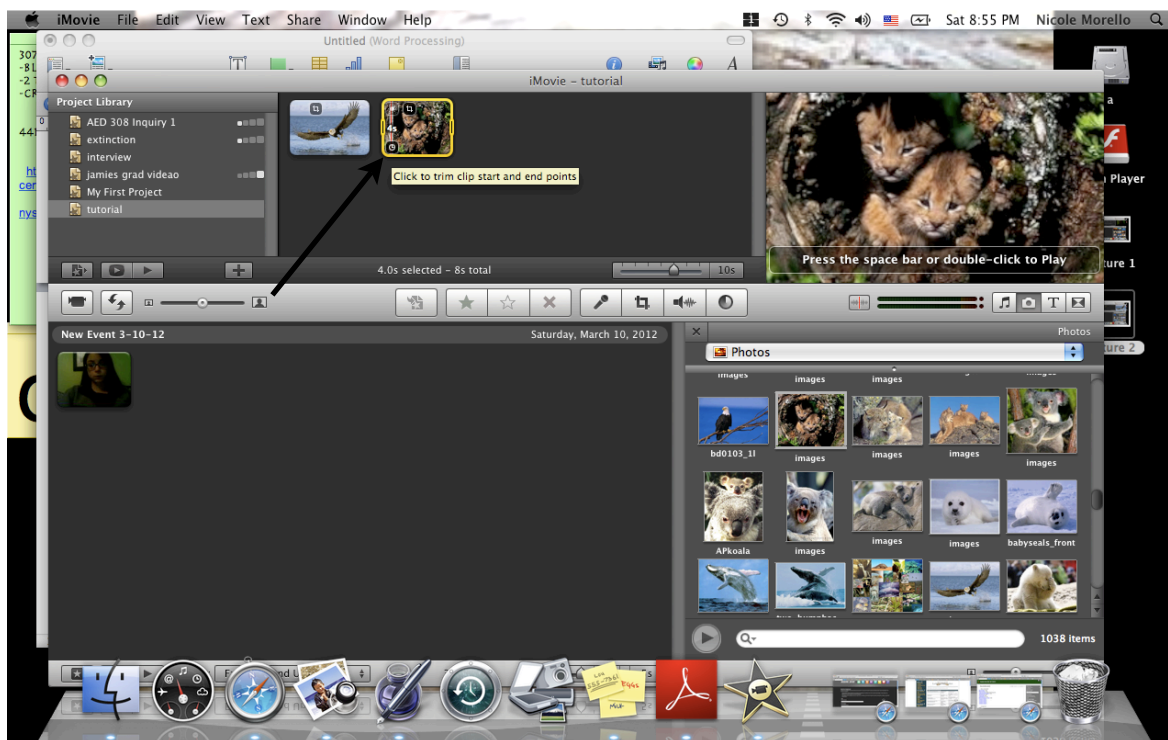


10. You will then drag as many of the pictures as you need next to each other in the frames above.

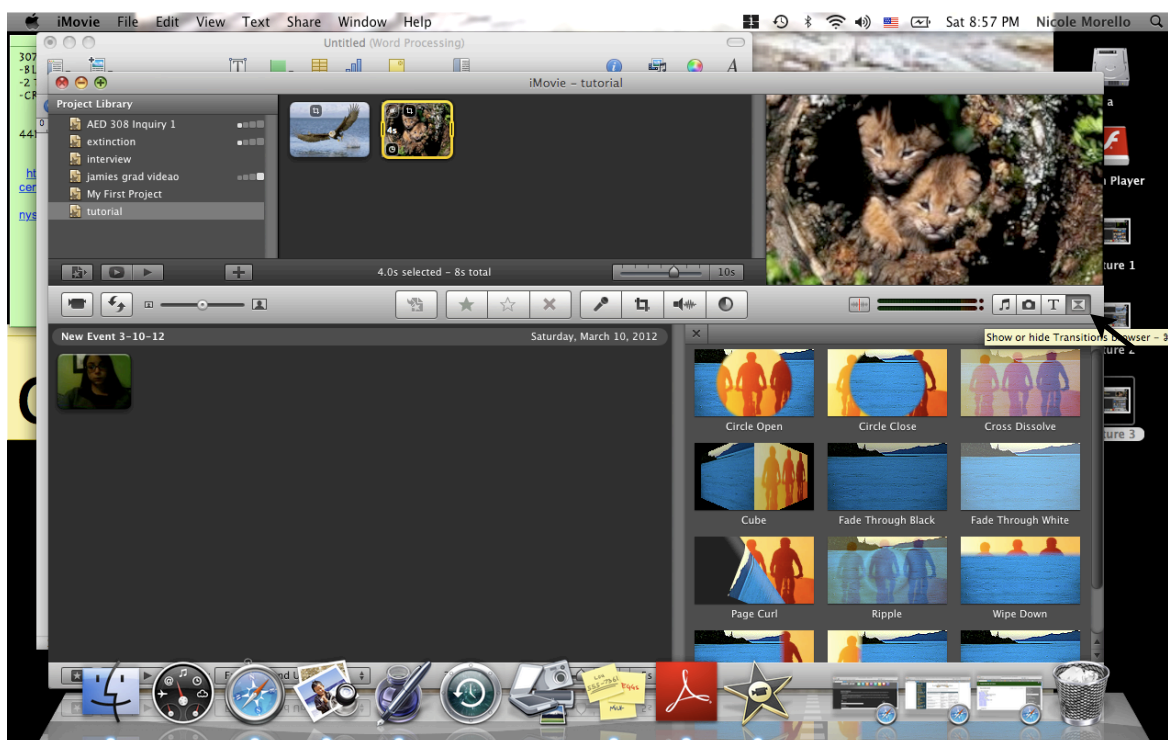




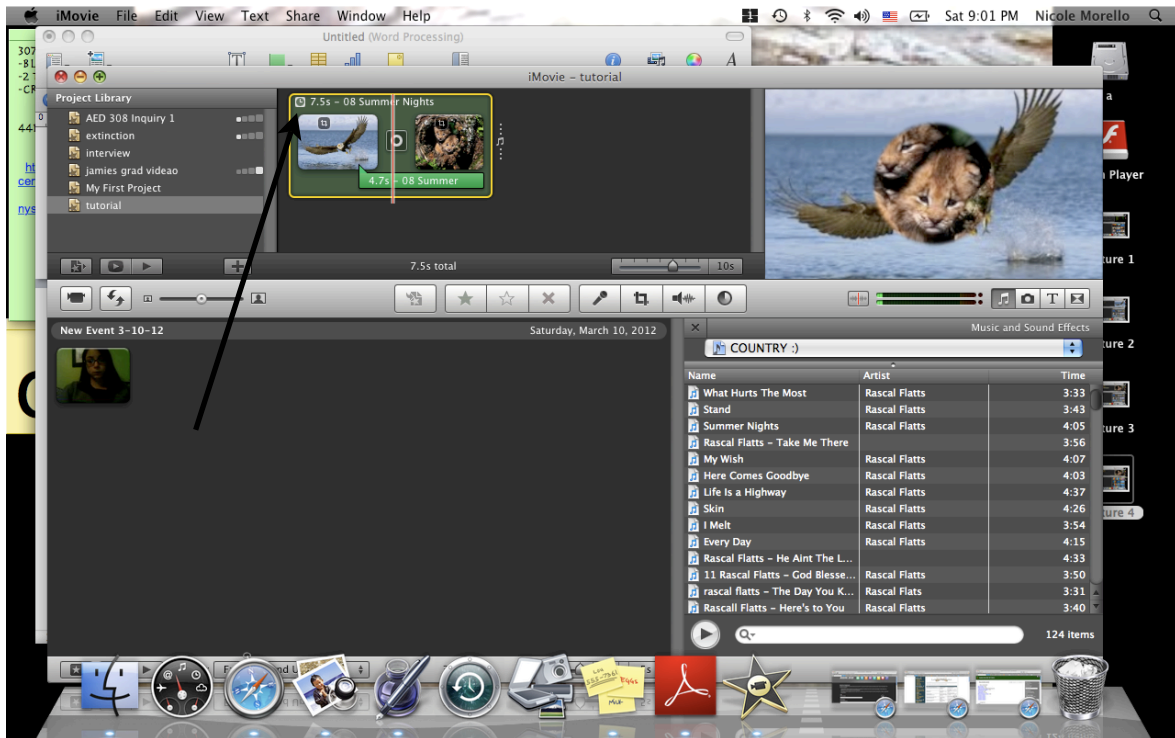
11. Once you have your pictures above, you can play around with the lengths of time. Click the clock in the bottom left corner of each frame and type in how many seconds you want that clip to play.



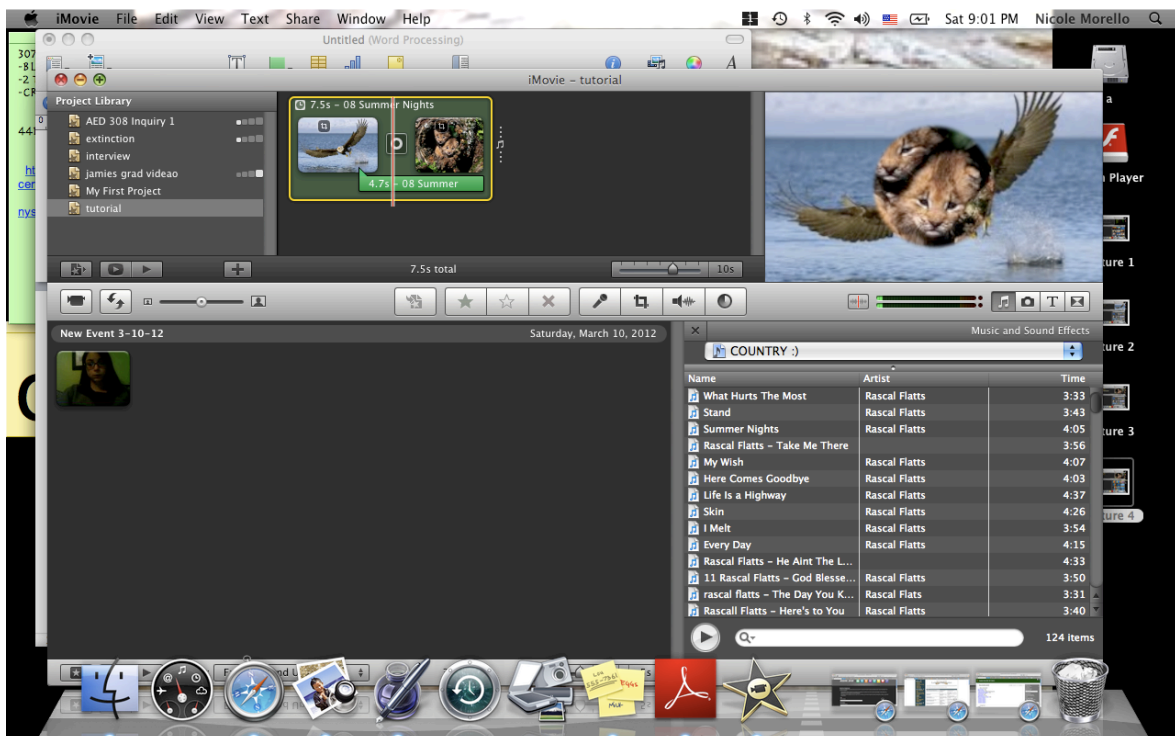
12. Once you have adjusted the time length, play around with the transitions between each frame. Click the icon to the very right and scroll through the options. You will drag the transition between the two pictures.



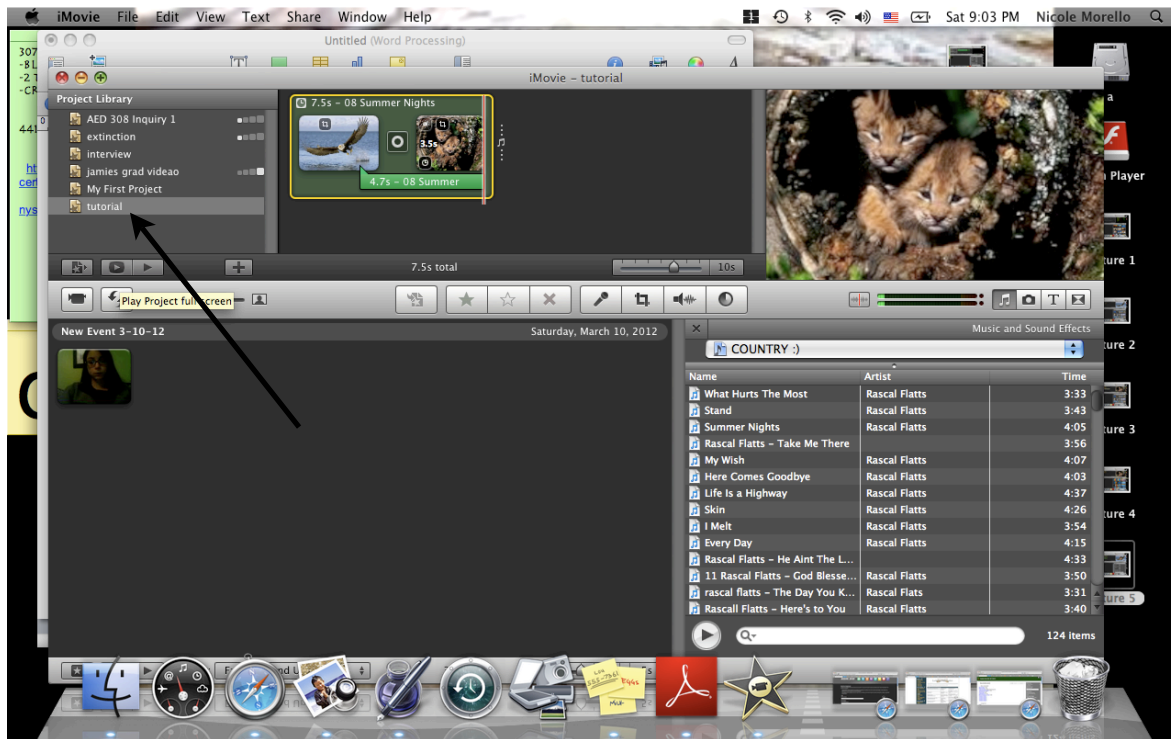
13. After you have your transitions in place, if you need music, you will click the music icon to the left, which brings you to your iTunes account.
14. Click the song you would like and drag it over to your clips.
15. Once you have done this, you can change the length of the song by clicking the clock to the top left of the image.



16. This will then bring you to the screen where you can trim the music. You will drag the highlighted yellow box to the left, or right, to use only the section you want.



17. Once you have everything in place, play it back to make sure it is just right. It will be automatically saved.



18. If you want to post it on youtube or export it onto your flash drive, double click the file name to the left. Then you are all set!
