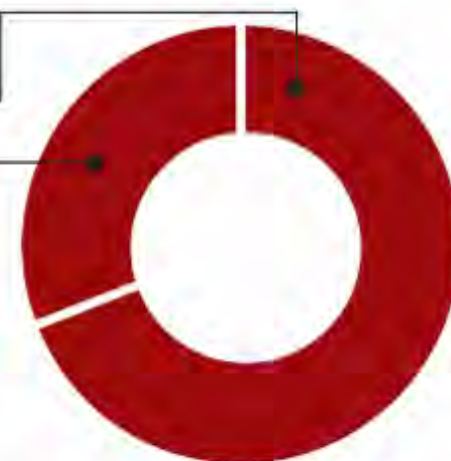

Certification Program for IT Architects

Arab News

The Open Group has announced that its IT Architect Certification Program is "open for business." Experienced IT architects can now apply for certification in the program. The criteria for applicants are at www.opengroup.org/itac.

Developed in response to the increasing demand for experienced IT architects, the program defines a set of worldwide standards for measuring the skills and experience of IT architects and for the operation of IT architecture practices within enterprises. The Open Group IT Architect Certification Program will offer the first independent, comprehensive, global certification for determining the skills, experience and knowledge of a professional IT architect.

IT architects who wish to be certified will need to meet the required levels of experience and skill and will be interviewed by a peer panel of certified IT architects. They will be able to achieve the IT Architect Certification in two ways: Either by applying directly to The Open Group or by going through a certification program that has been accredited by The Open Group. The skill and experience requirements for both the direct certification and the accredited certification are the same.

Certified IT architects will be entitled to use an official certification mark as an indication of their status and will be listed for public reference in the Certification Directory maintained by The Open Group. The initial certification cost is \$1,250 per individual, with a subsequent \$175 annual fee for maintaining the Directory of Certified IT Architects.

IBM Donates Development Assets to Eclipse

IBM Tuesday announced its plans to donate some of its strategic software development assets to the open-source community, in an effort to help organizations adopt and share best practices for building software.

IBM officials said the company will donate a subset of the IBM Rational Unified Process to the open-source community. RUP is a development methodology that comes out of IBM Software Group's Rational business unit. Grady Booch, an IBM fellow and Rational's chief scientist, said RUP is a vast collection of methods and best practices for promoting quality and efficiency throughout software development projects.



With a new tool suite designed to streamline common tasks.

The company said more than half a million developers have used RUP in building systems ranging from small departmental systems to complex, mission-critical systems such as weapons systems and air traffic control applications.

IBM is planning to donate the RUP subset to the Eclipse Foundation, which IBM founded and spun out into an independent organization early last year. Booch said IBM hopes its donation will help form a foundational architecture and Web-based tools for the industry to engineer, collaborate on, share and reuse software development best practices.

Moreover, IBM said the move is to help promote "a collaborative, industry-wide effort to synthesize, share and automate development processes and best practices among independent software vendors, IT organizations building integrated software systems, academia, the research community and individual software professionals on small or large teams," according to a company description of the effort.

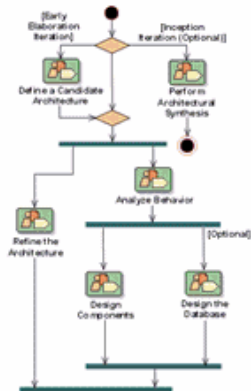

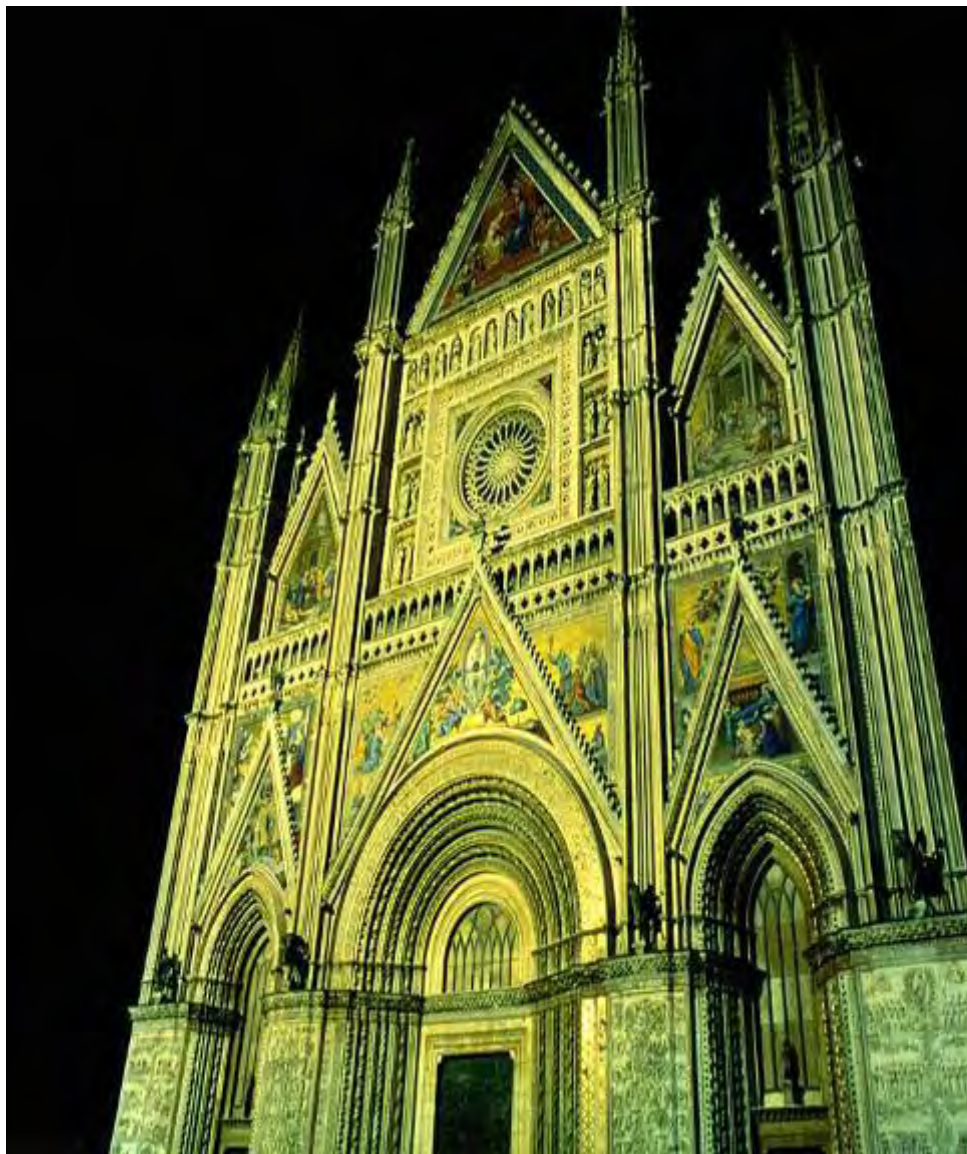

The Network is the Computer

Allow me to once again apologize in advance for a lack of brevity. This is one of those blogs you wait a career to write.

A few years ago, I was sitting across from a Wall Street CTO, one of many I was visiting in New York. I was asking them all the same question: "Do you feel this grid you're building is delivering a competitive advantage to your business?" (For those that don't know what a grid is, it's a collection of low cost network, storage, computing and software elements, lashed together to do work that historically required very expensive, dedicated proprietary technologies). I asked the same question of CTOs in the energy industry, using grids to find oil. In the life sciences industry, using grids to discover drugs or model proteins. In the movie industry, using grids to render movies.

The answers I received, typically delivered by an impressioned CTO that had spent a year building a grid, was always the same: "absolutely yes. Our grid is way better than any of our competitors."

I haven't stopped asking that question. But about a year ago, after Sun outlined plans to build a public, multi-tenant grid (just like the power companies run), and make it available for \$100/hour, and after a few industry notables began suggesting change was afoot, I started hearing a different tune. "Um... maybe my grid's no different than anyone else's."

Now, since John Gege first uttered the phrase, Sun has been saying "The Network is the Computer." It's one of those rare vision statements that only becomes more true over time. And next week, we're going to prove the point by unveiling the world's first on-demand supercomputer. And by on-demand, I mean accessible through your browser, with a credit card. This isn't yesterday's definition of On Demand, involving custom financing contracts, prepositioned inventory and a sales rep in a crisp blue suit ready to negotiate. Nope, our definition is just like eBay's: you bring a browser and a credit card, we offer the service. No fuss, no muss. We believe the simplicity, accessibility and affordability of this service changes the face of computing for all organizations, large and small, public or private.

- 1977 - Two Boeing 747 jumboes collided in the Tenerife disaster on Tenerife's Canary Islands, killing 683 people in one of the worst aircraft accidents in aviation history.
