- Brainstorm ideas about curiosity

### Teacher's Responsibility:

- Provocations
- Active Listening
- Documentation
- Observe students and interactions

## Step 2 (Dive into a Topic) Skills

- Make a plan
- Figure out ways to answer questions
- Exploration
- Discovery
- Collaboration
- Communication
- Resiliency

## Activities to Develop Skills

- Utilize other school professionals (art, library, performing arts, etc.)
- Students interviewing each other
- Asking questions of each other
- Ask themselves questions to instill curiosity

## Teacher Responsibility:

- Guide students to find answers through providing resources (internet, books, peers, professionals)
