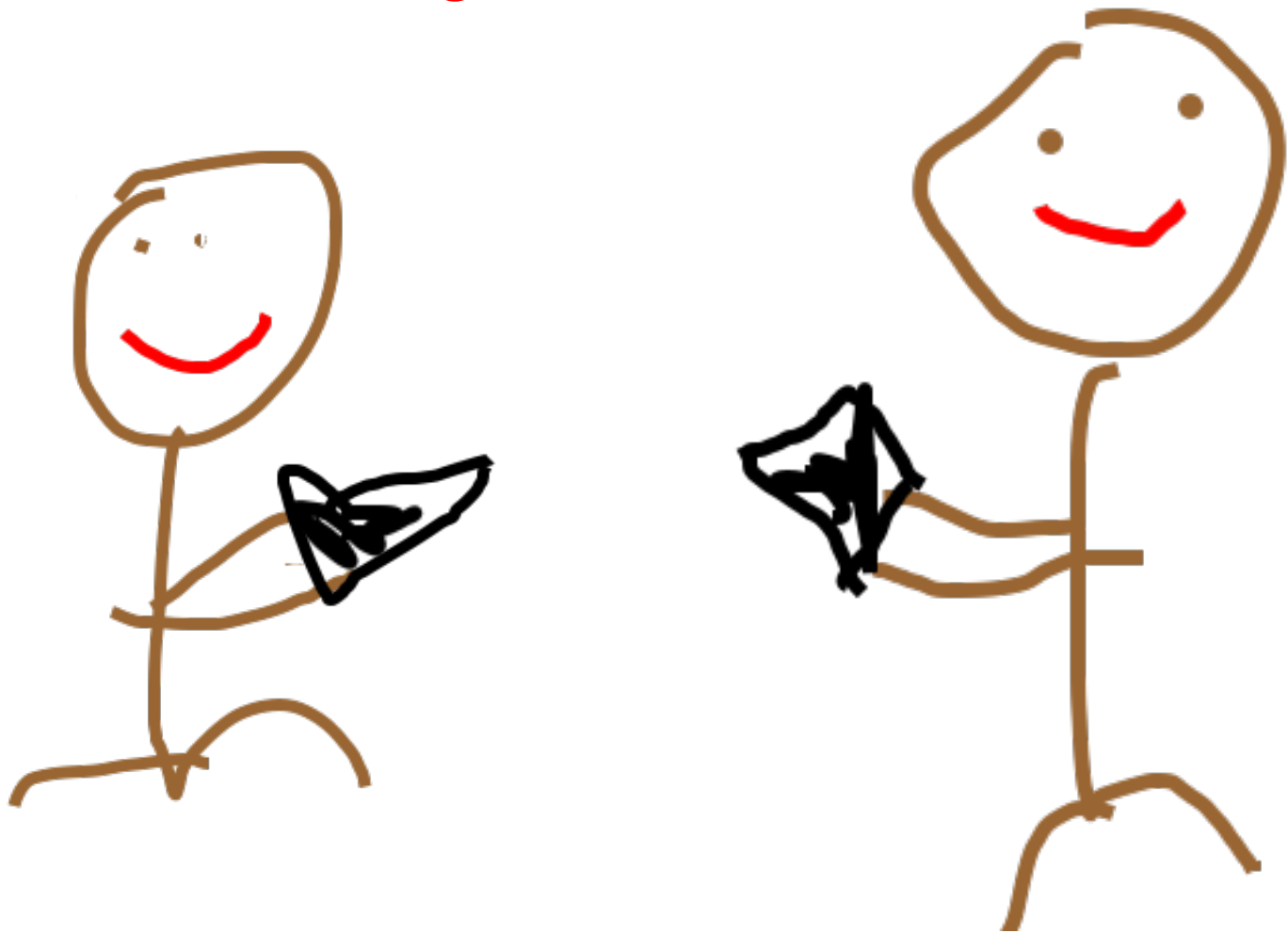
## Chapter 2:Pottery

When the Pueblos didn't have lots of things(besides food!),they would go to other tribes to trade.They ask for their goods but the catch is that they have to give something back in return.



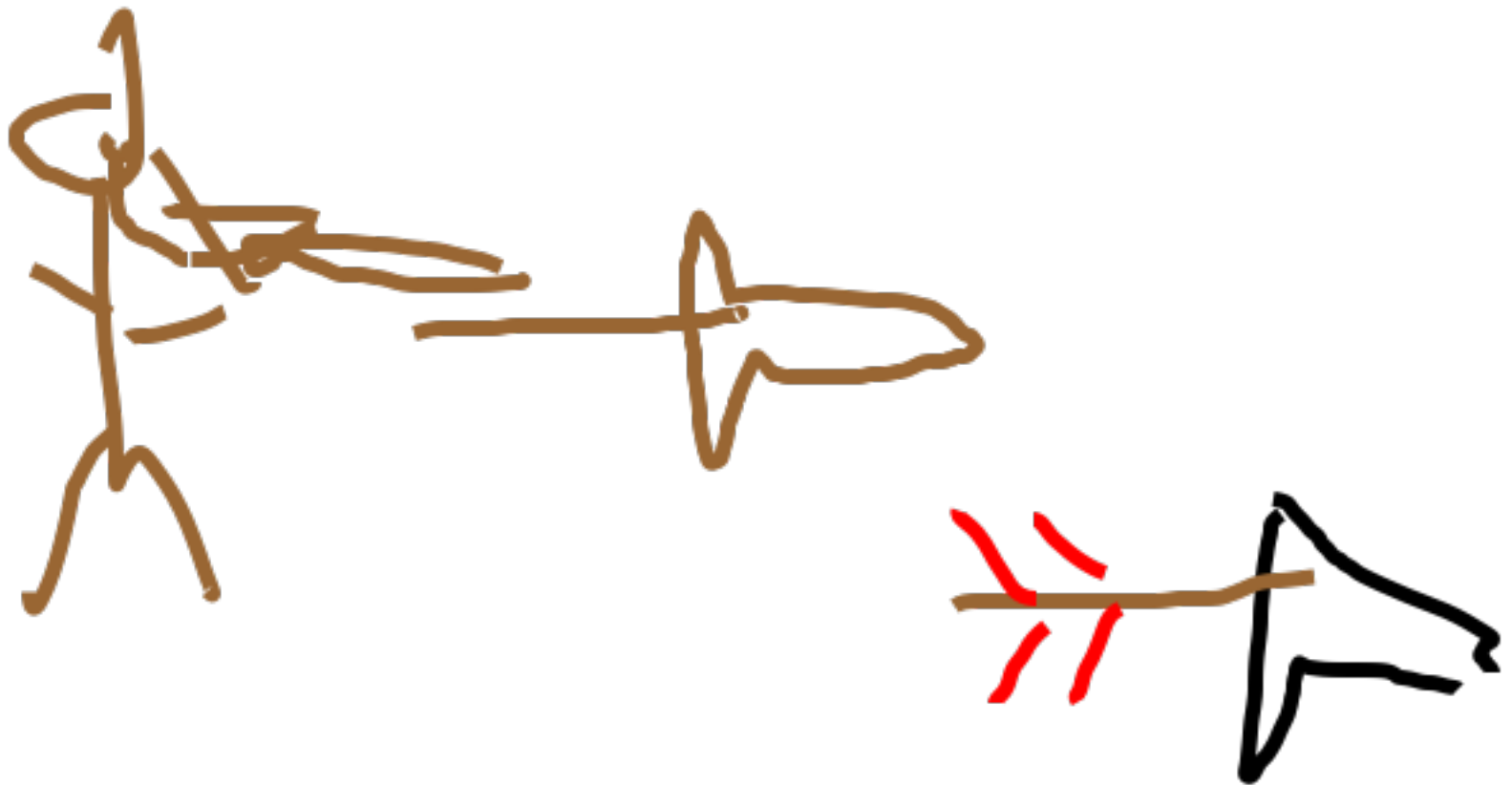
# Chapter 4:Houses and Buildings

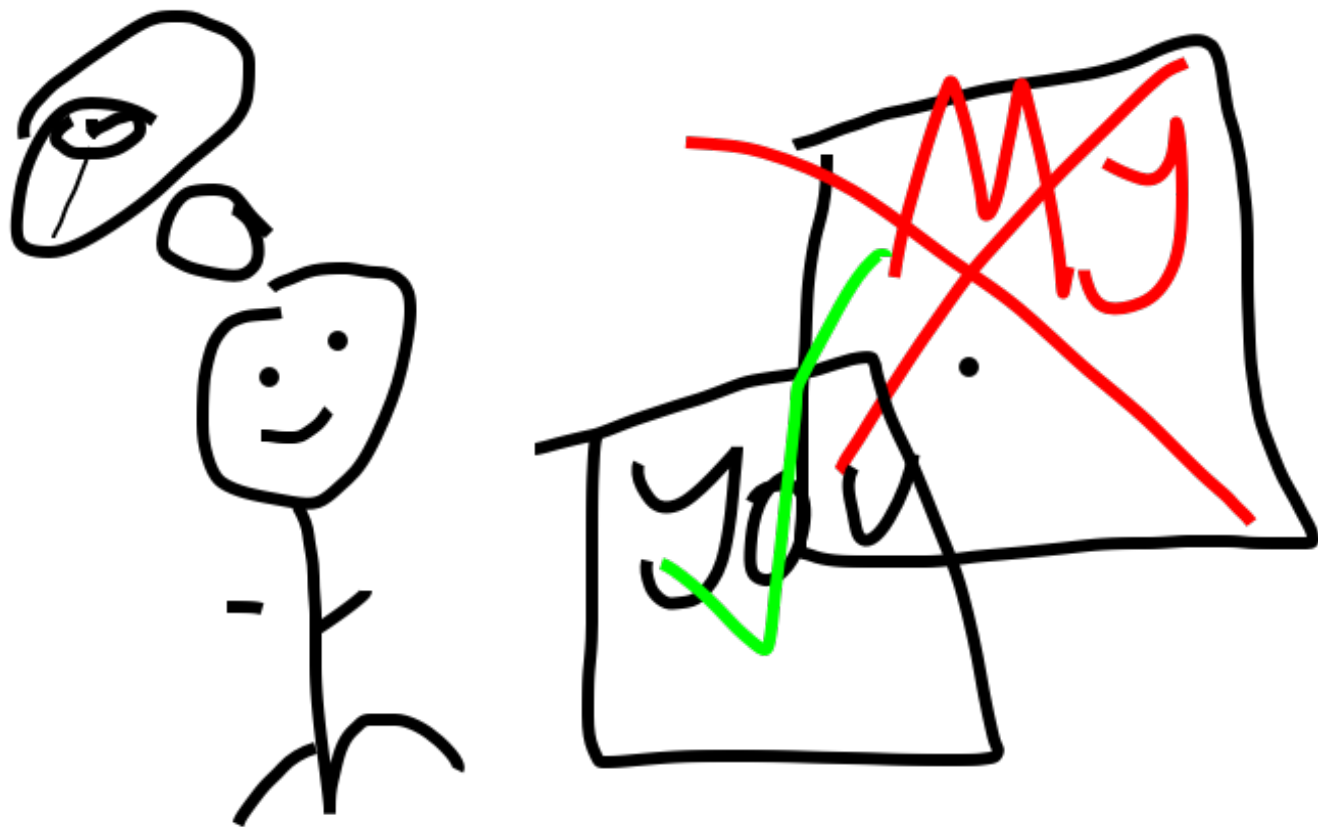
## Chapter 5: Weapons
